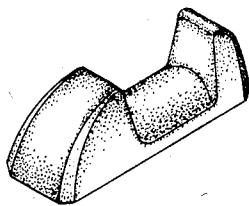

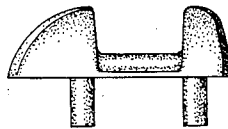

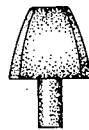

SUPPORT FOR A LUGGAGE HANDLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Abraham Levine, a citizen of the United States, residing at Elizabeth, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Support for a Luggage Handle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

In the drawings:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a support for a luggage handle, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the support;

Fig. 3 is a top plan view of the same; and

Fig. 4 is an end elevational view of the same viewed from the left in Fig. 2.
