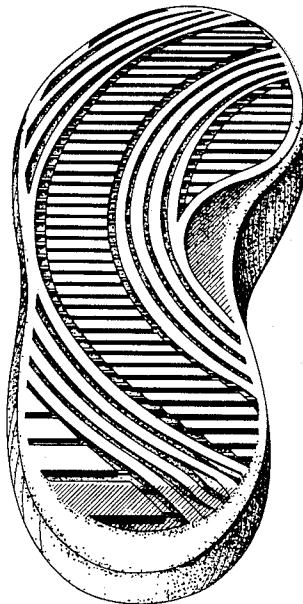

CLAIM

The ornamental design for an athletic shoe outsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of an athletic shoe outsole showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereto, the broken-line showing of a shoe is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



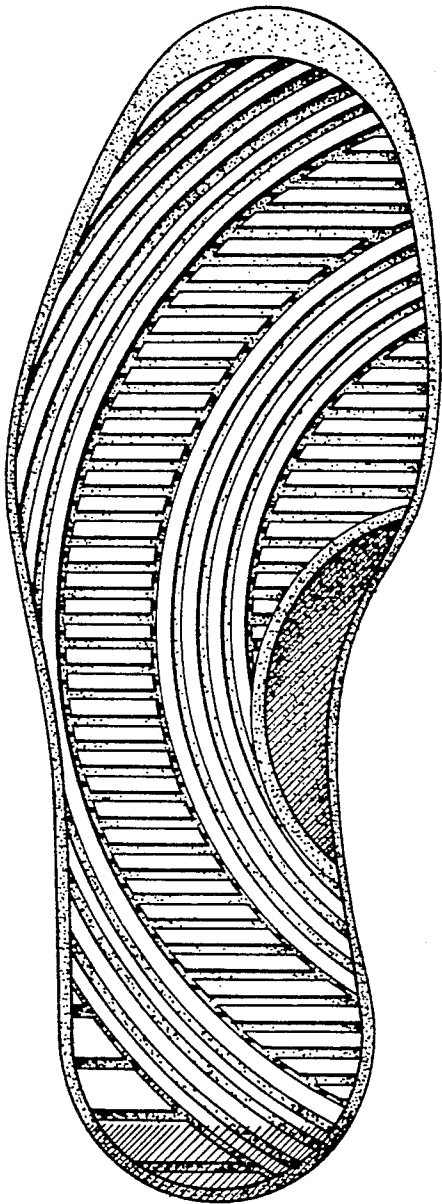

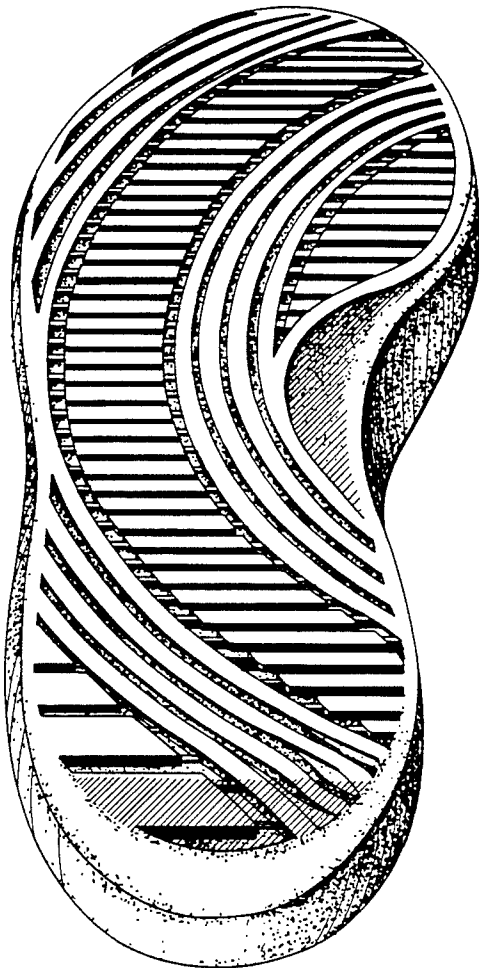

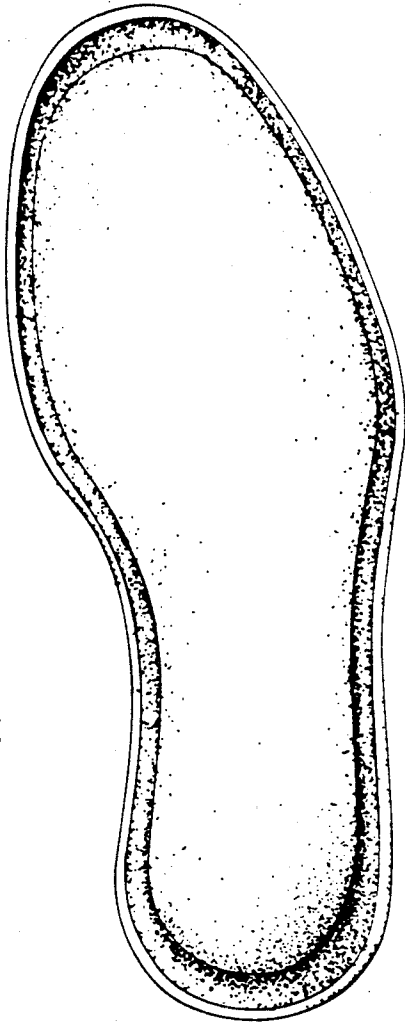

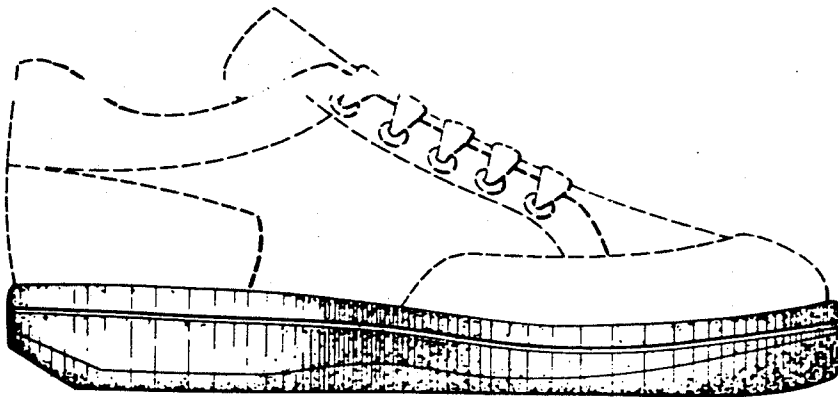
