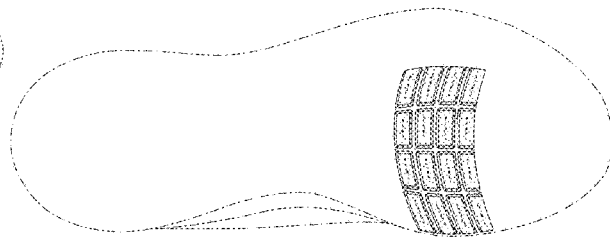
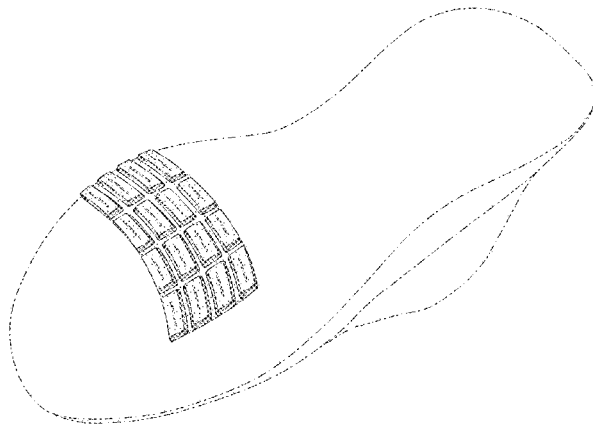
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof; and, FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof. The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The broken lines showing of the sixteen race-track shaped elements form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

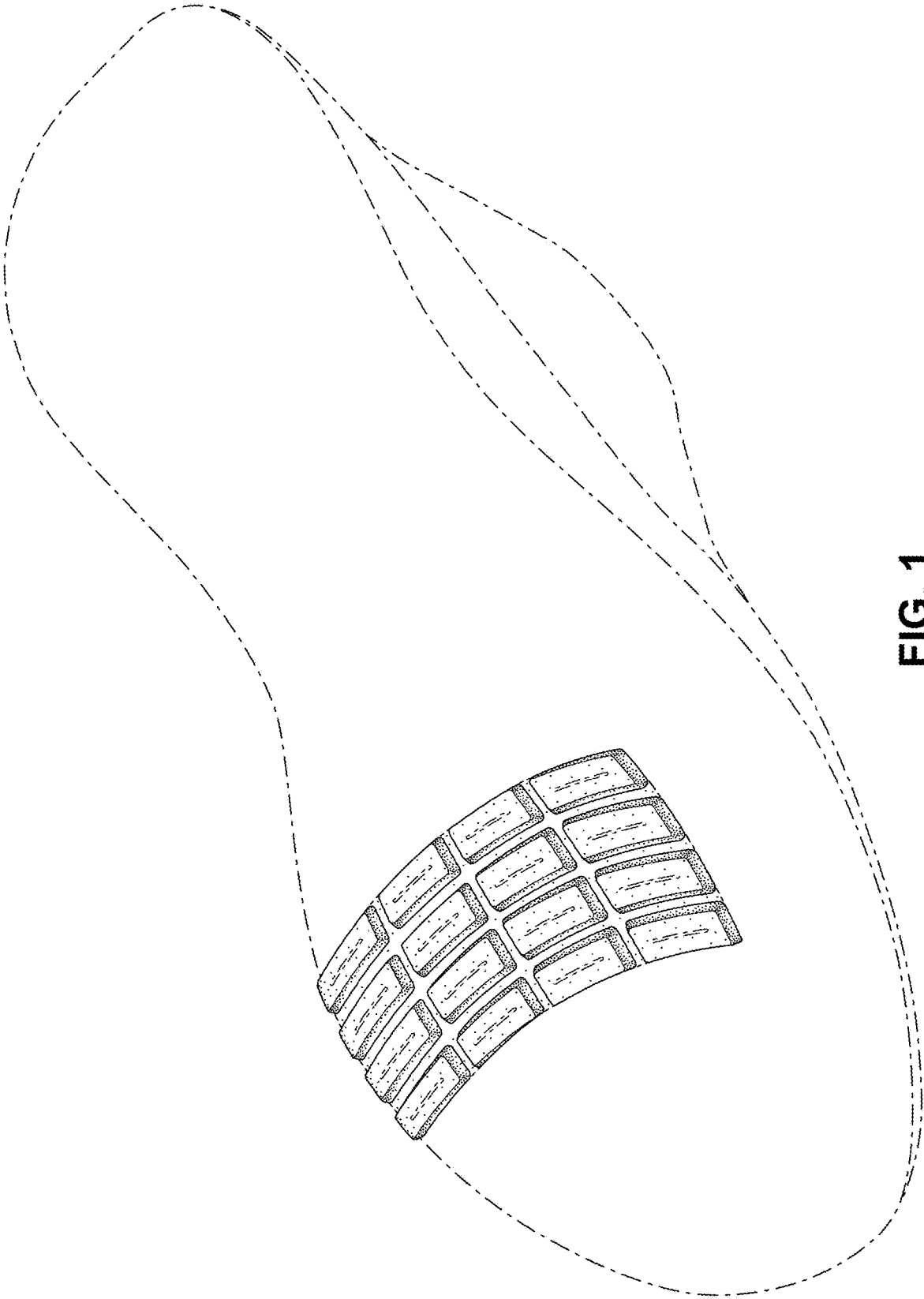

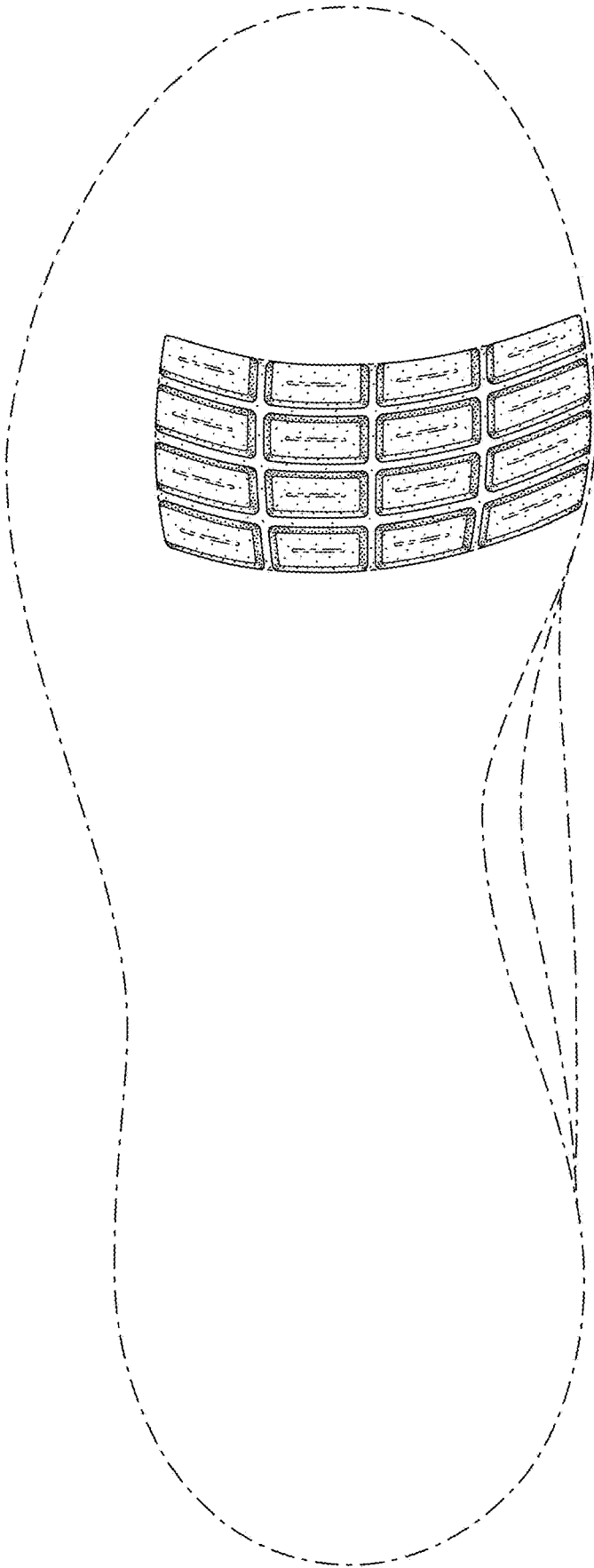

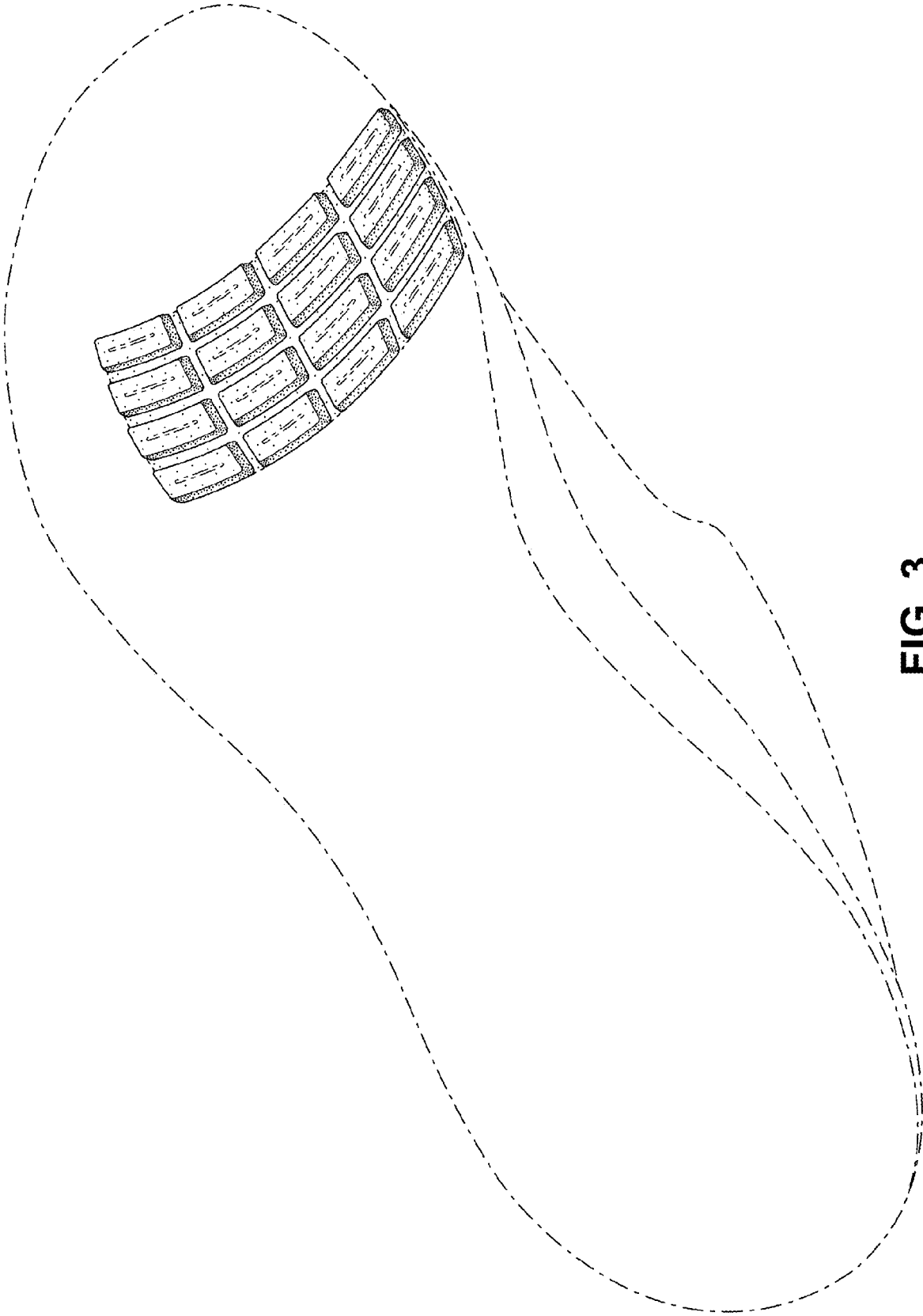
