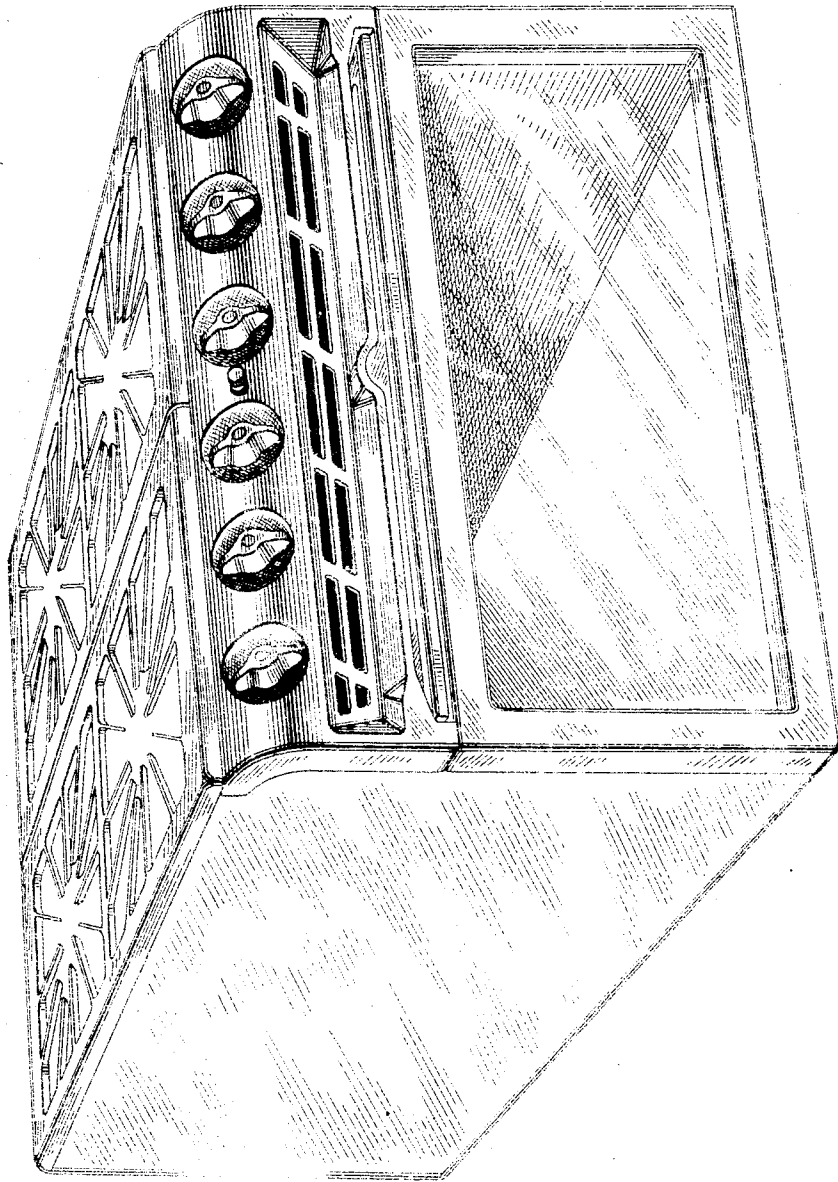

DESIGN FOR A GAS RANGE TOP SECTION
