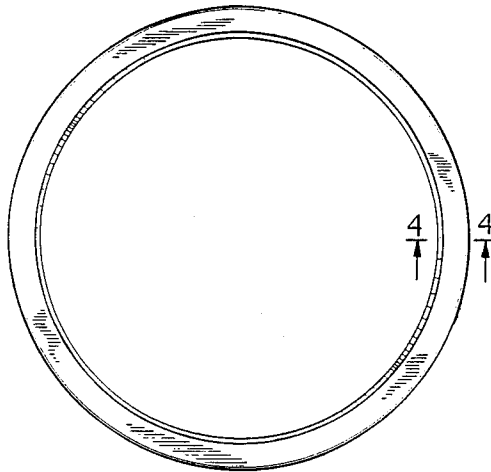

FIG. 4 is a partial cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1.



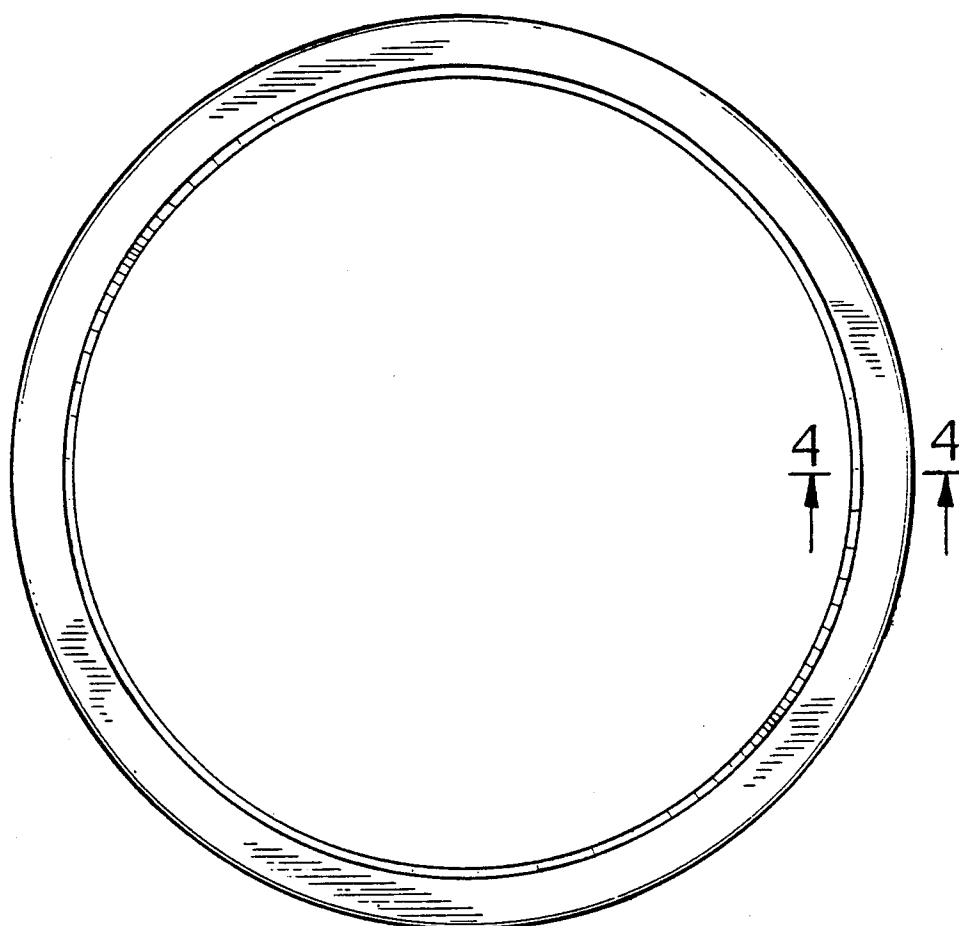

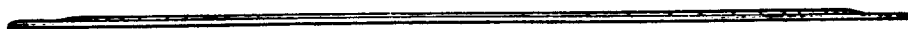

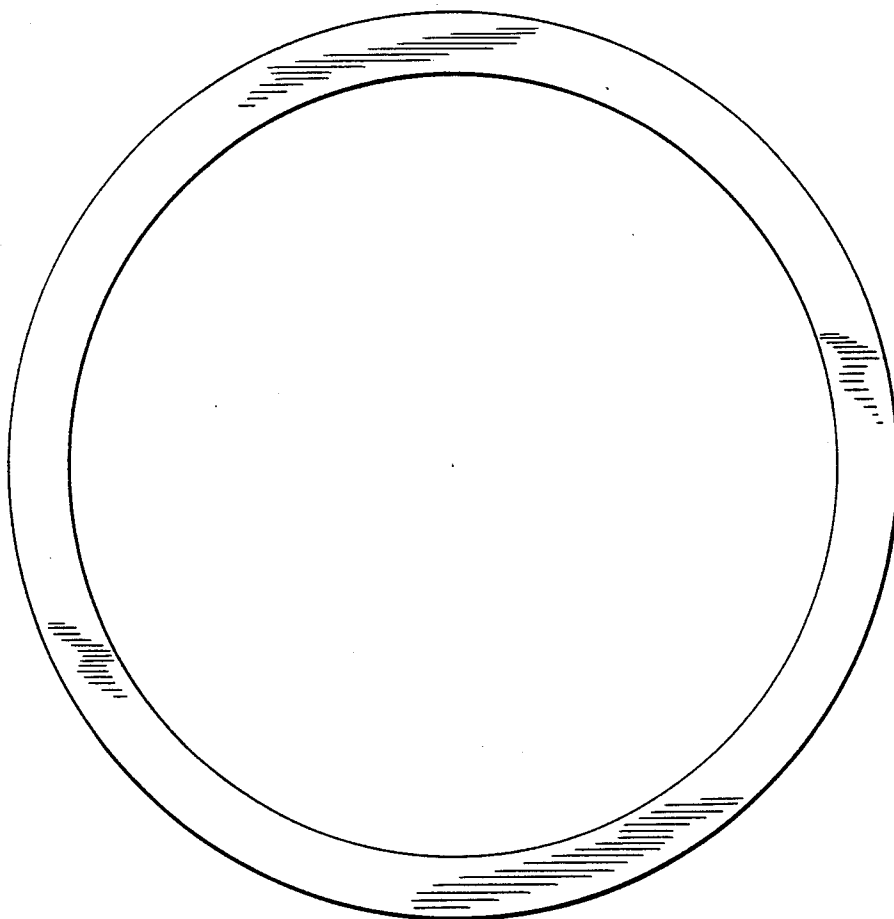
