The ornamental design for a video cassette recorder or the like, as shown.

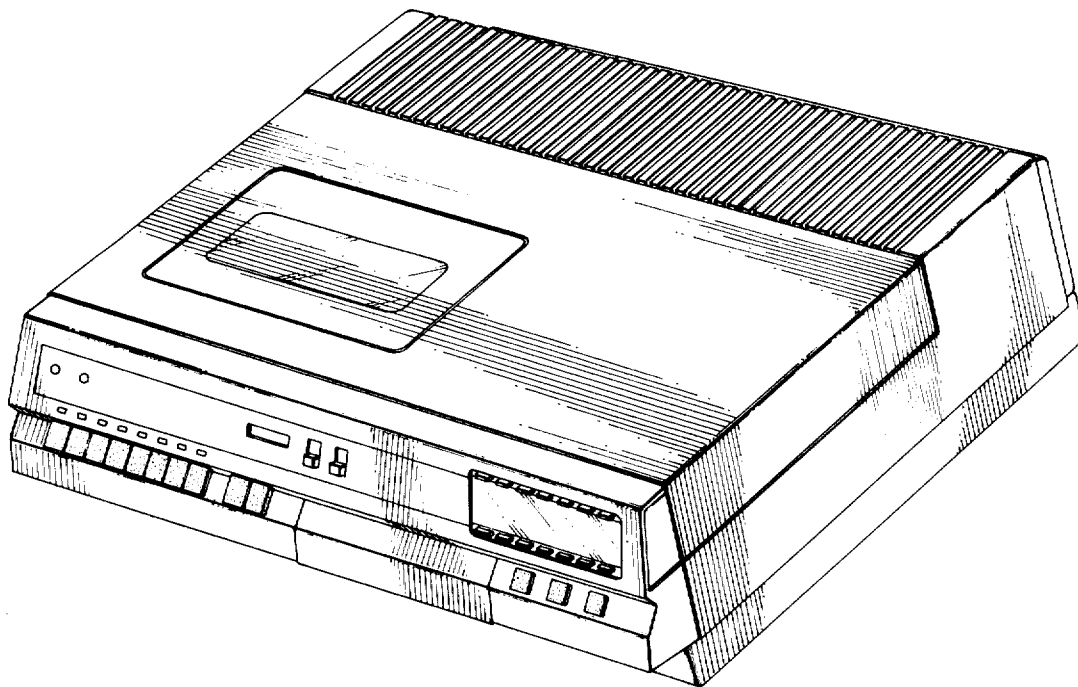
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



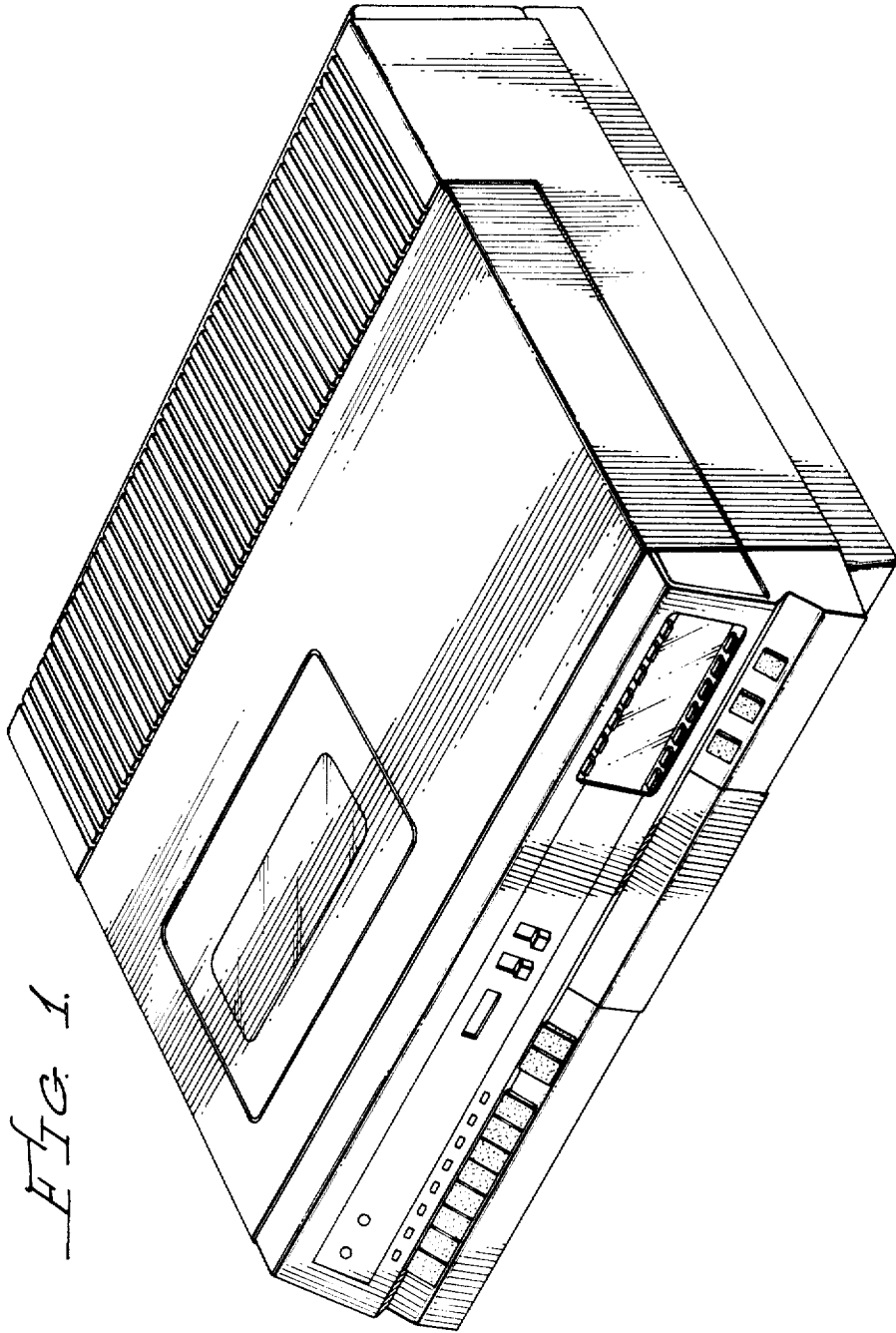

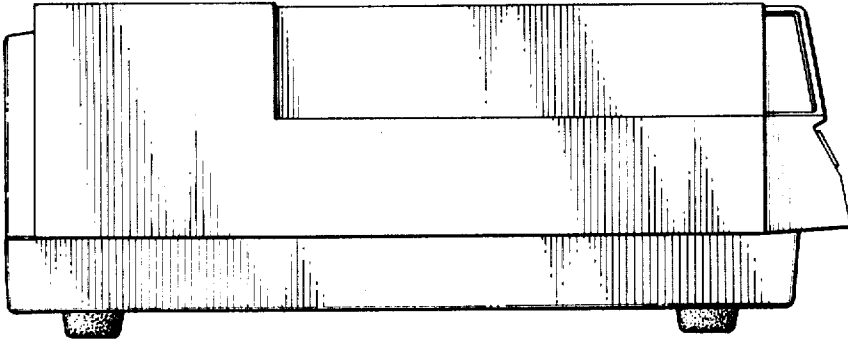

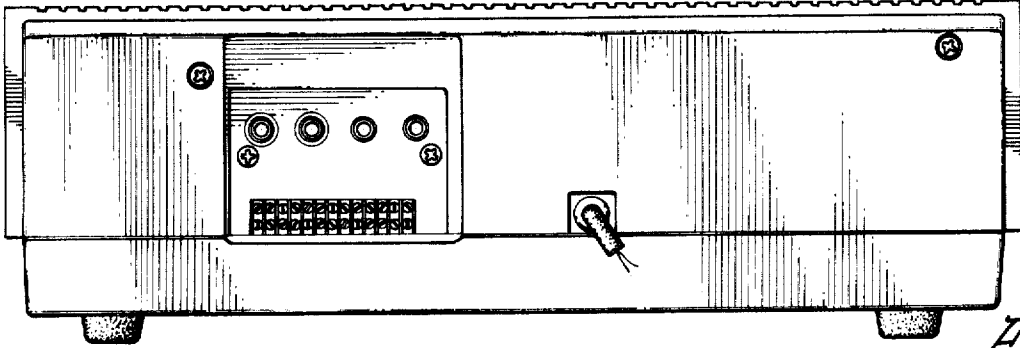
