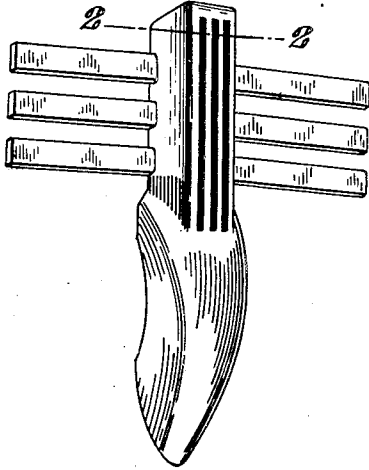

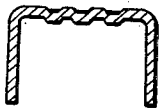

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis S. Poncher, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bumper Guard, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a bumper guard showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an enlarged transverse sectional view taken on a line corresponding to line 2—2 of Fig. 1.
