The ornamental design for hitch assembly for trailer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my hitch assembly for trailer showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a reduced top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a reduced left side view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a reduced front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a reduced right side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a reduced bottom view thereof.
