

DESIGN FOR A TABLECLOTH OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles I. Betesh, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tablecloth or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein the figure is a fragmentary plan view of a tablecloth showing

my new design. The vertical dot and dash lines outline substantially one-half the design unit, the other half being the same, but arranged in proper relation to complete the tablecloth.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a tablecloth or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
