CLAIM

The ornamental design for a reflective tag for animals, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of the reflective tag for animals of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the reflective tag for animals of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the reflective tag for animals of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the reflective tag for animals of FIG. 1, the right view being a mirror image thereof:

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the reflective tag for animals of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 6 is the bottom plan view of the reflective tag for animals of FIG. 1.

The broken lines showing of a cow in FIG. 1 and the #"3" in FIG. 1 and FIG. 2 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.


