











FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the replacement window with one of the sash members removed therefrom, the other end of the replacement window and sash unit being identical to that shown.

FIG. 2 is an internal view in elevation of the replacement window with the sash members in closed position.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view in elevation showing details of the sash member positioned in the jamb of the replacement window.

FIG. 4 is an external view in elevation of the replacement window with the sash members in closed position.

FIG. 5 is a vertical sectional view of the replacement window and sash unit taken along the line 5-5 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 6 is a horizontal sectional view of the replacement window and sash unit taken along the line 6-6 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 7 is a bottom view in elevation of the replacement window.
