

To all whom it may concern:

Be is known that I, Robert Zelenka, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Key Retainer, Flashlight, and Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined key retainer, flashlight, and lighter, showing my new design:

Fig. 2 is a top plan view looking in the direction of arrows 2—2 on Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view looking in the direction of arrows 3—3 on Fig. 1;

Fig. 4 is an end elevational view looking in the direction of arrows 4—4 on Fig. 1;

Fig. 5 is an end elevational view looking in the direction of arrows 5—5 on Fig. 1; and

Fig. 6 is a view similar to Fig. 1 with the cap removed from the lighter structure.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined key retainer, flashlight, and lighter, substantially as shown.
