CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ornamental child's pillow in the fanciful form of an ape with a numbered banana design on its chest taken from above the right front corner; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view the right side being a mirror image thereof.

The stippled shading represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend uniformly throughout the areas represented.
