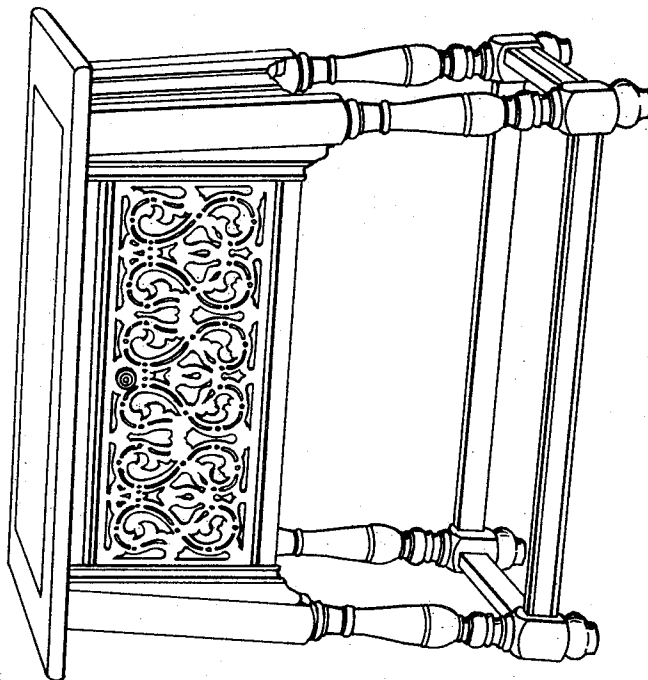

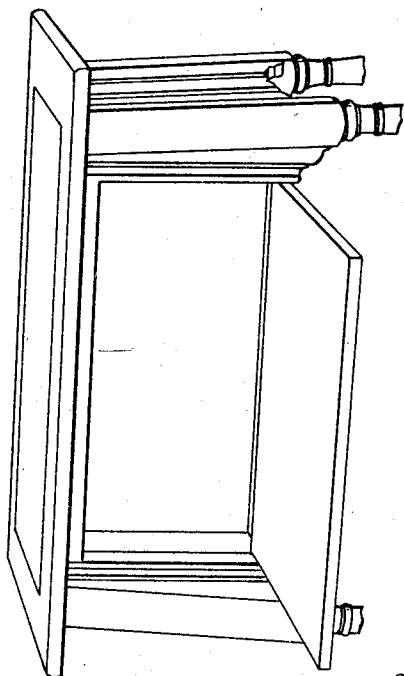

DESIGN FOR A RADIOCABINET OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE J. PIKE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Grand Rapids, in the county of Kent and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Radiocabinets or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a

cabinet showing my new design, the doors of the cabinet being shown closed.

Fig. 2 is a front perspective view of a fragmentary portion of the same cabinet with the doors thereof in open position.
