




Fig. 2. Invertor James a adams Luy Curryngham — Mitorney.

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC.

27 Pleasant Street, Waltham, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Textile Fabrics, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, form-

ing a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a portion of the textile fabric showing my new design;

Fig. 2 shows on a larger scale the openwork portions.

The dotted lines represent cords showing Be it known that I, James A. Adams, a upon the face of the fabric, held in place citizen of the United States, residing at No. by the weft threads. The background consists of warp and weft threads while the portions marked 3 are open-work portions, see Fig. 2. Contrasting colors may be used to bring out the design.
