[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a front housing for a portable radiotelephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view thereof, with the broken line material included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan thereof, with the broken line material included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof, with the broken line material included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forming no part of the claimed design; and,

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof, with the broken line material included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and forming no part of the claimed design.

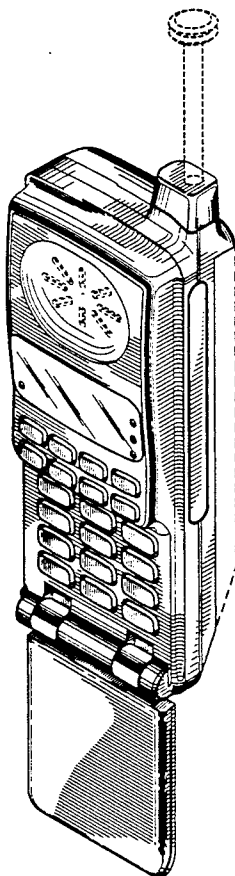

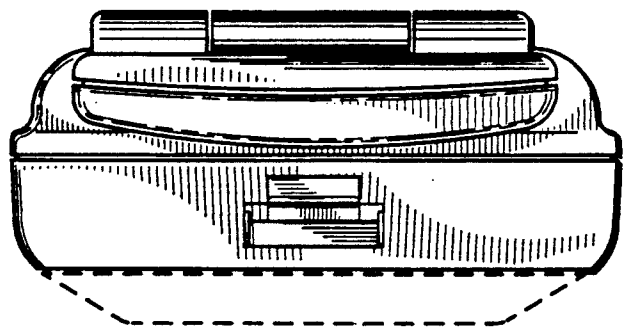
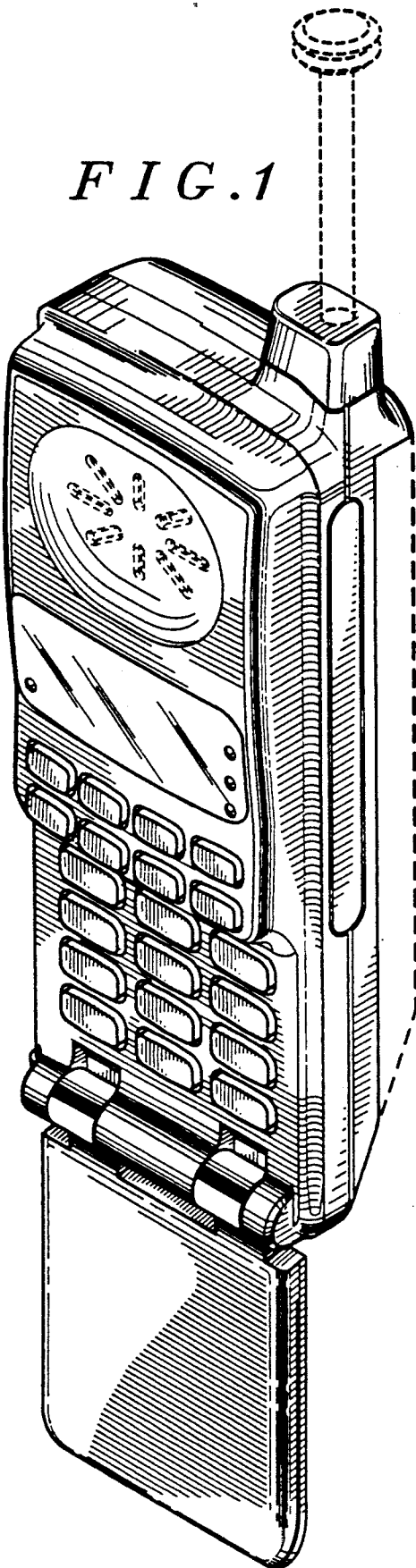
