(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an expandable baton handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a isometric view of an expandable baton handle; FIG. 2 is a top view of the expandable baton handle, wherein the bottom view is identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a right side of the expandable baton handle, where the left side view is a mirror image thereof;

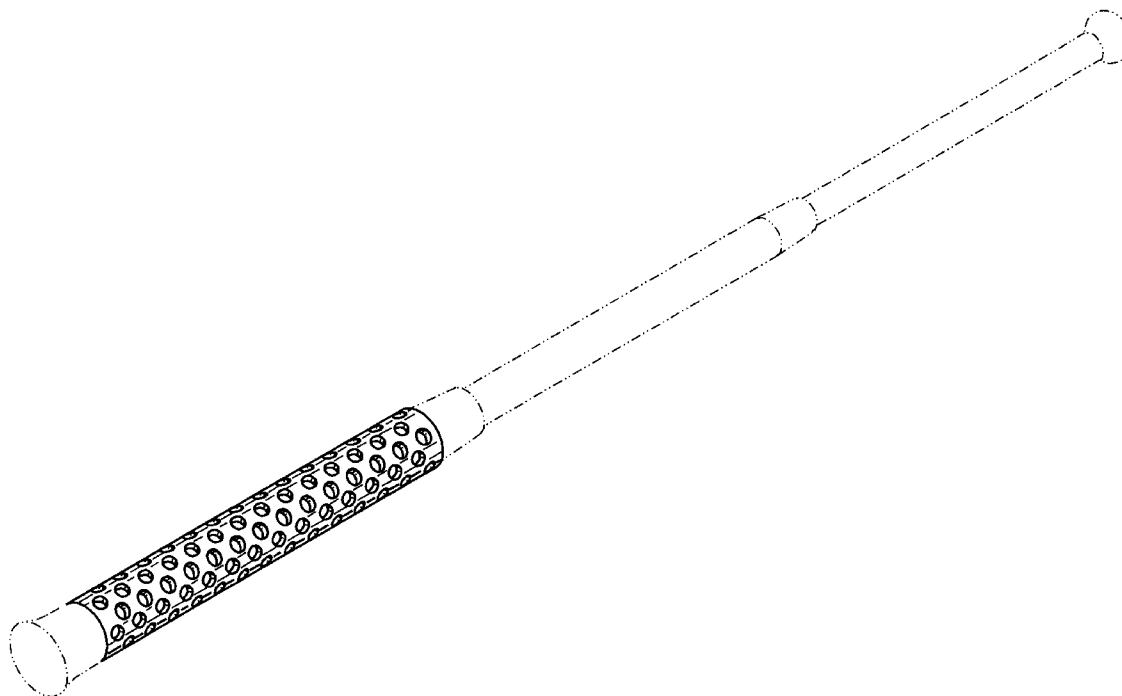
FIG. 4 is a front view of the expandable baton handle;

FIG. 5 is an isometric view of the handle with the expandable baton in the retracted position; and,

FIG. 6 is a top view of the handle with the expandable baton in its retracted position.

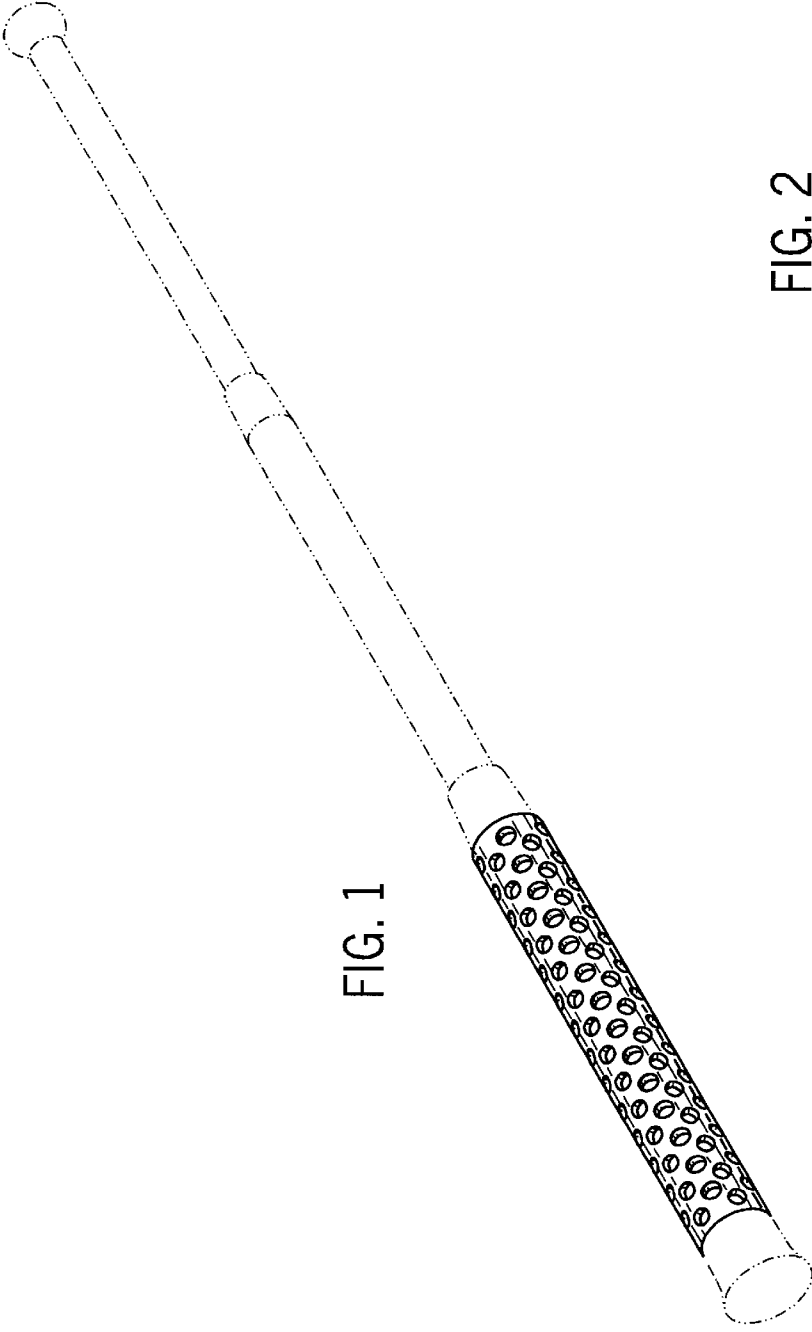

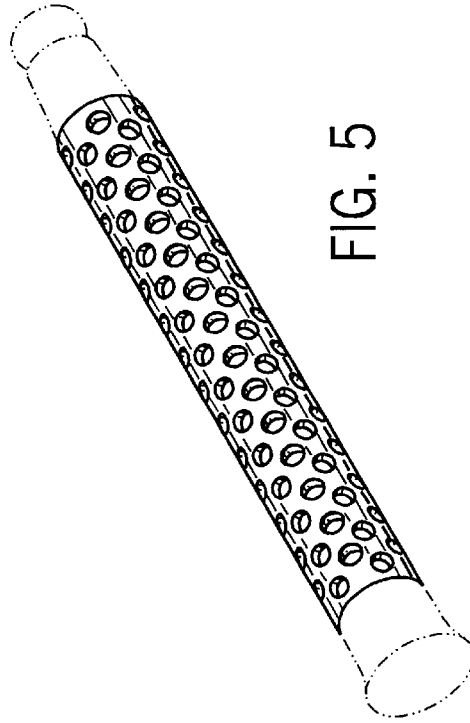
