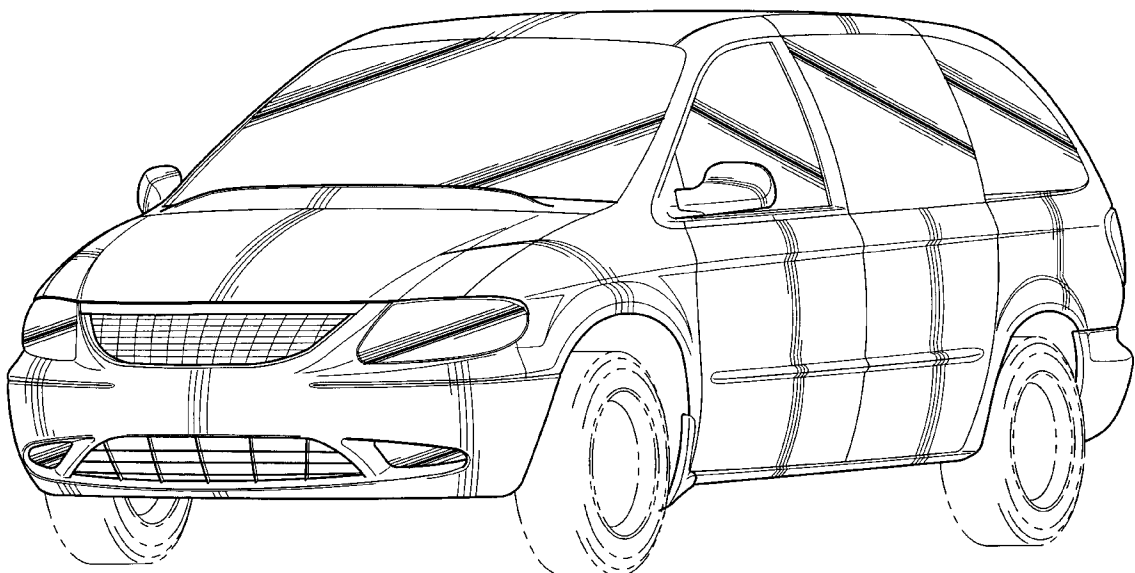
It will be further understood that the top is plain and unornamented.

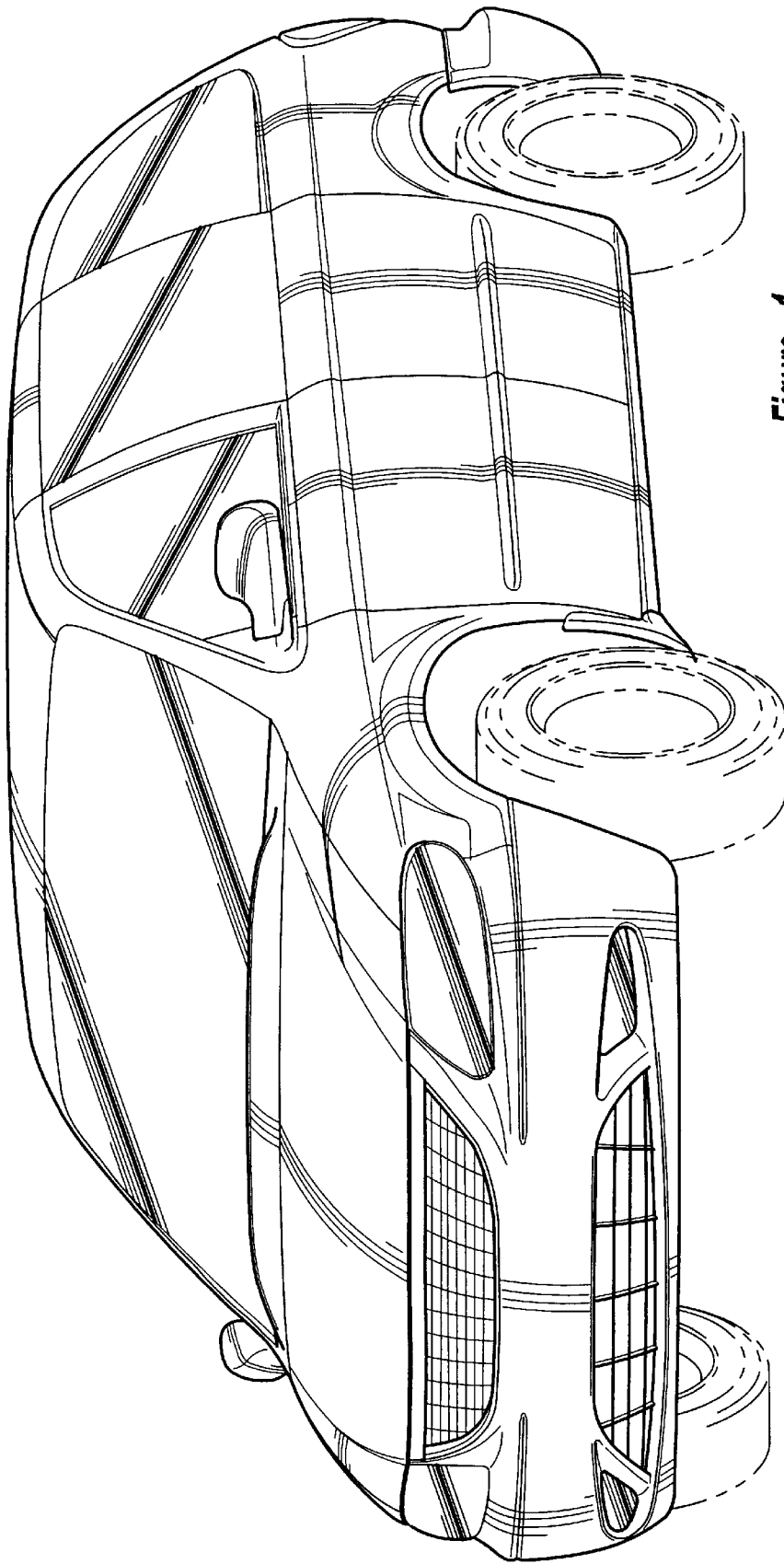

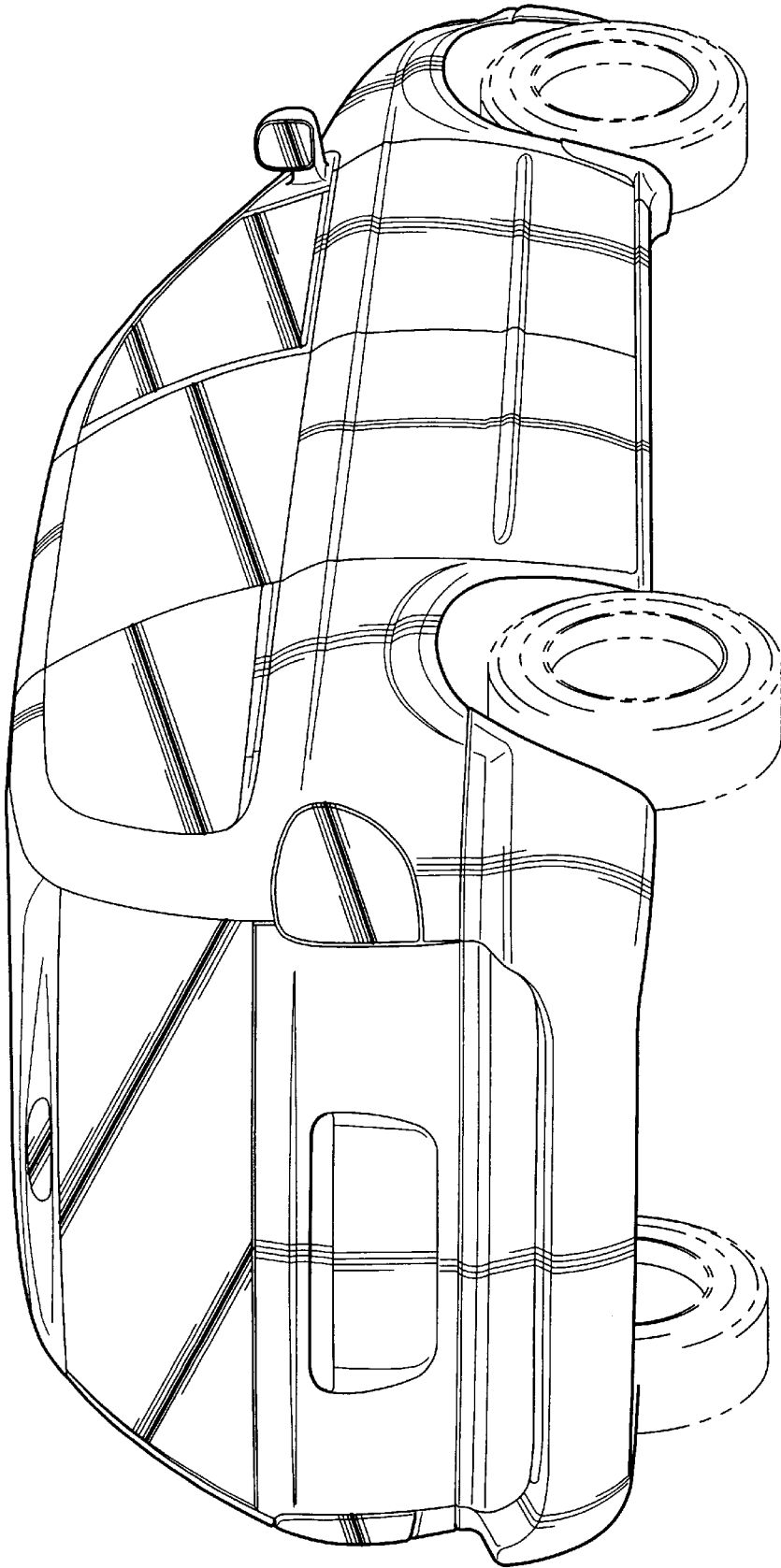

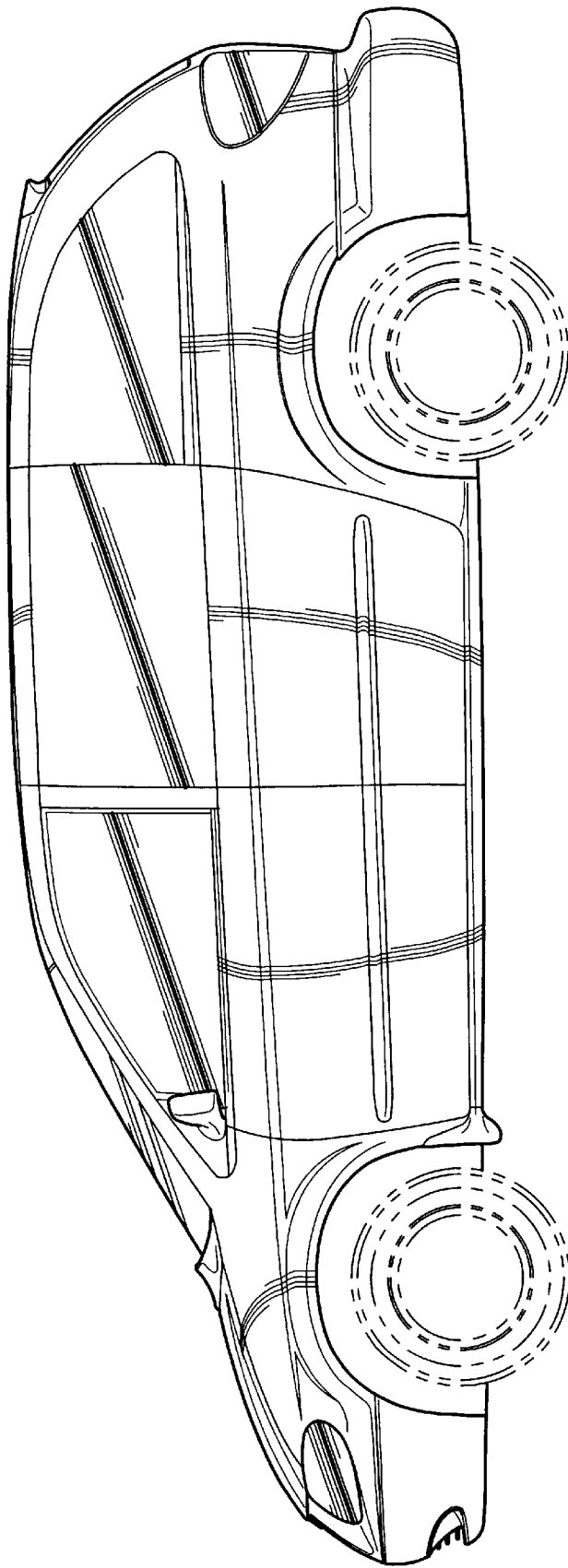

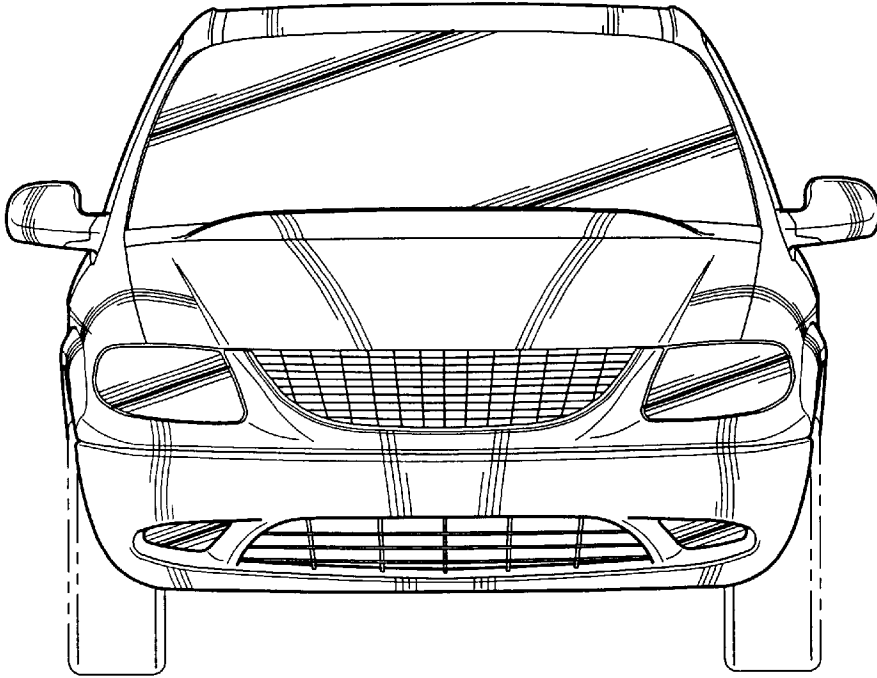

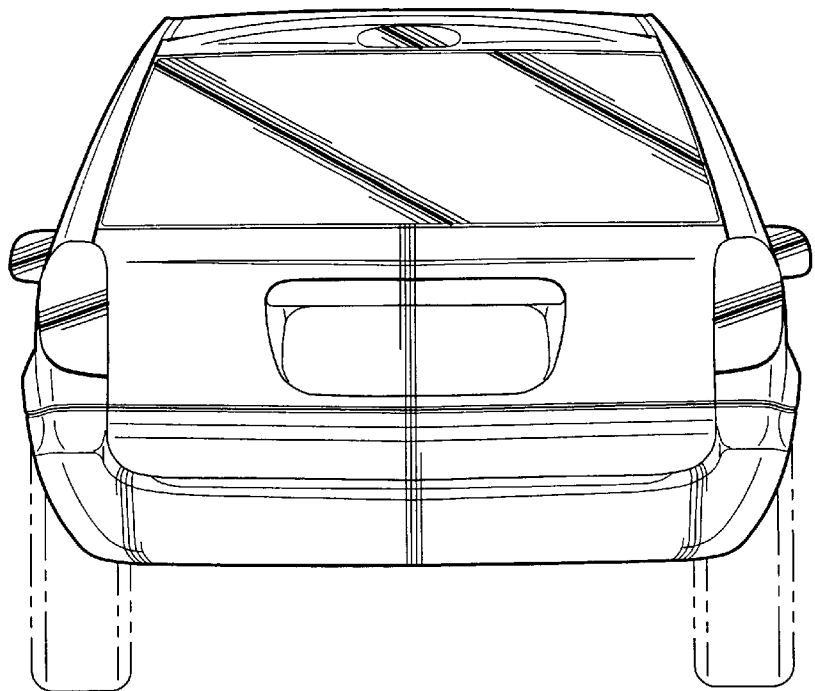

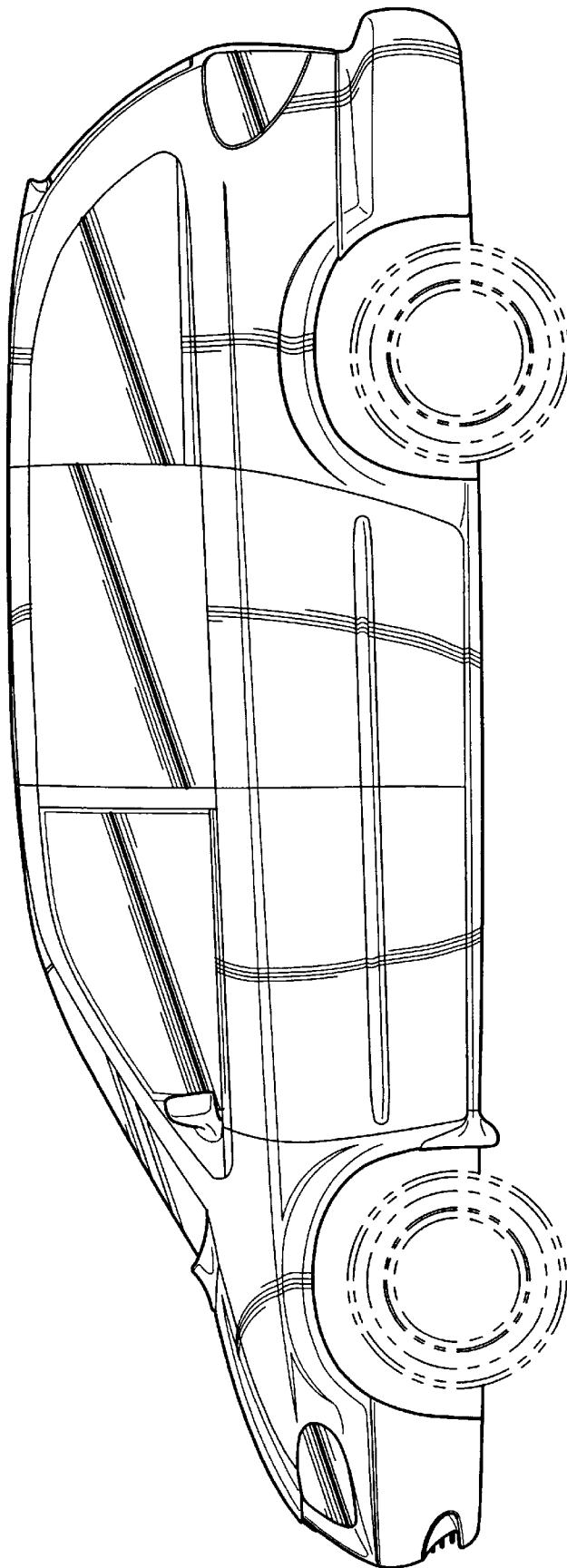

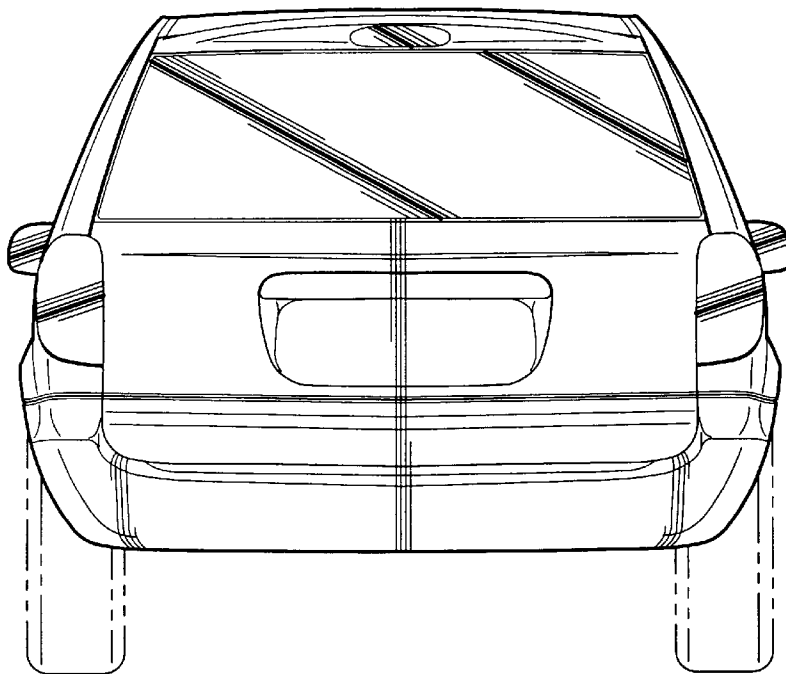
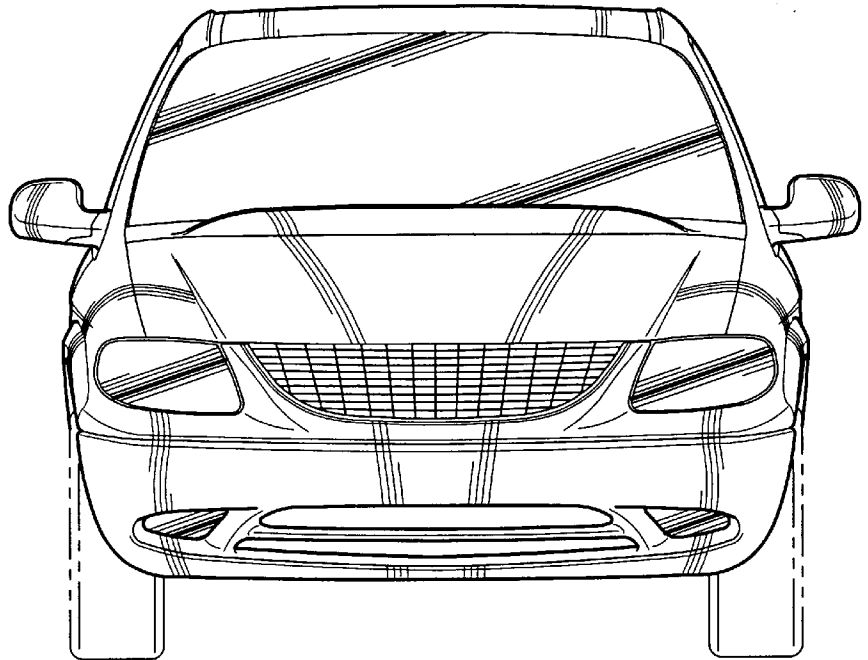
