


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Abraham L. Buschman, a citizen of the United States and resident of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Christmas Tree Lighting Set and Container Therefor or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which,

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a combined

Christmas tree lighting set and container therefor embodying my design with the package in closed position;

Fig. 2 is a perspective view thereof in open position.
