I claim the ornamental design for a crossbow, as shown and described.

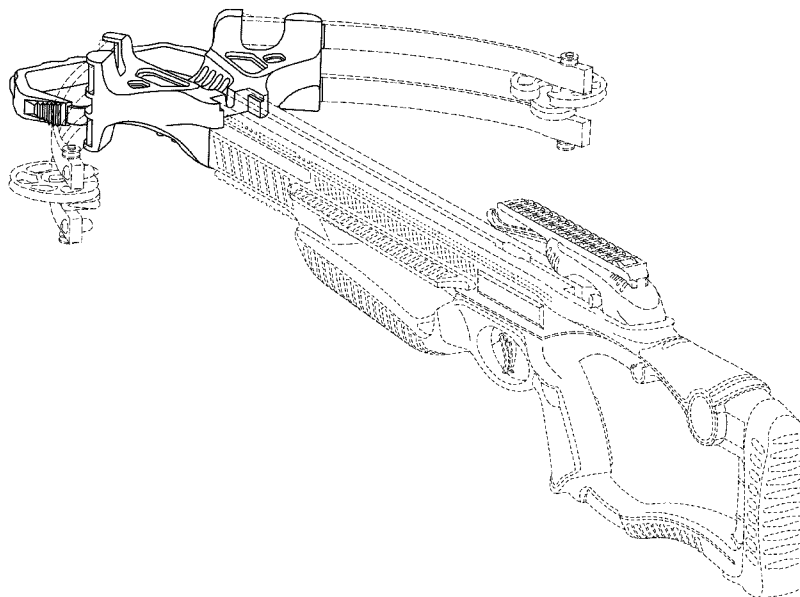
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective, side view of my new design;

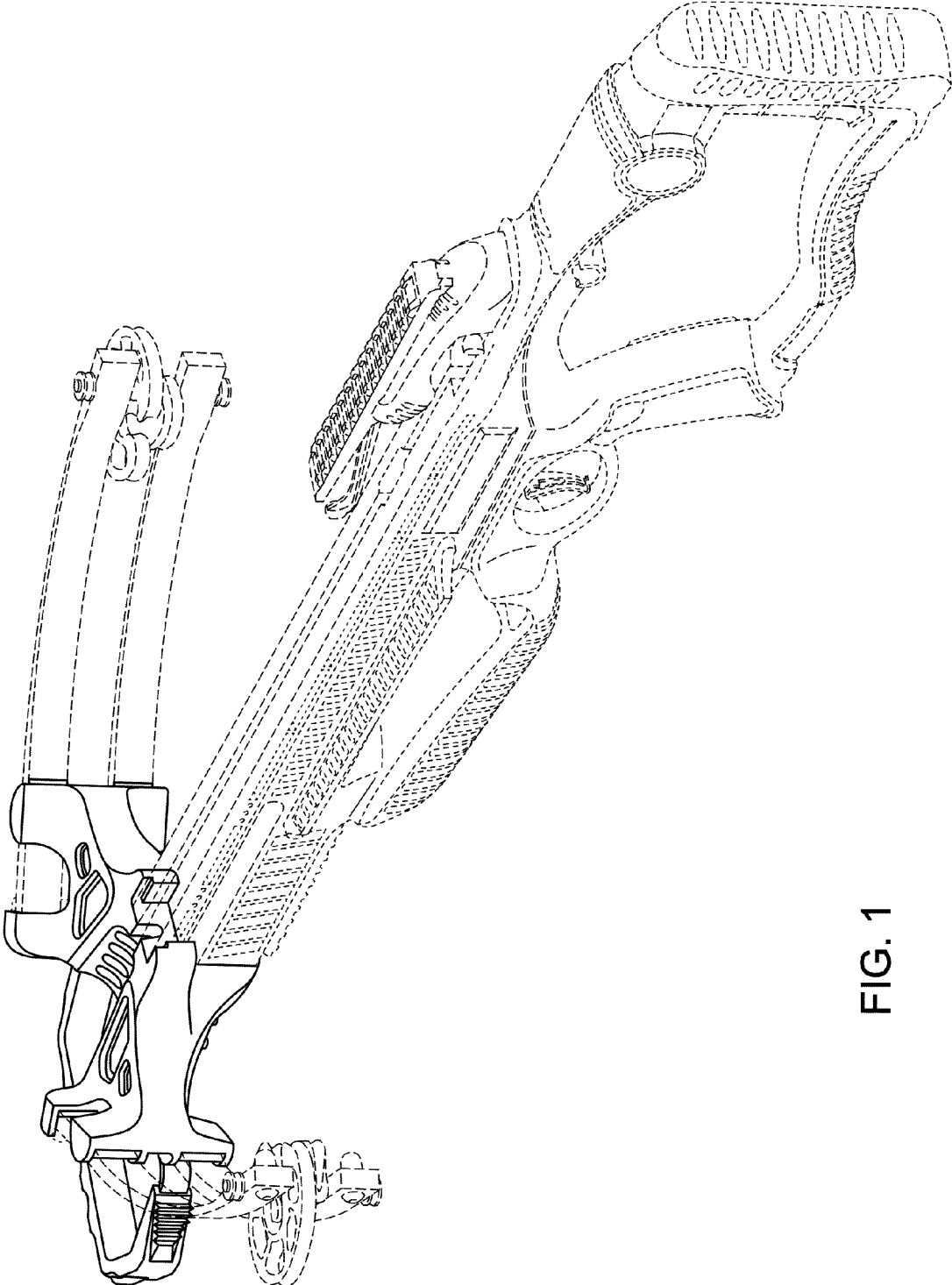

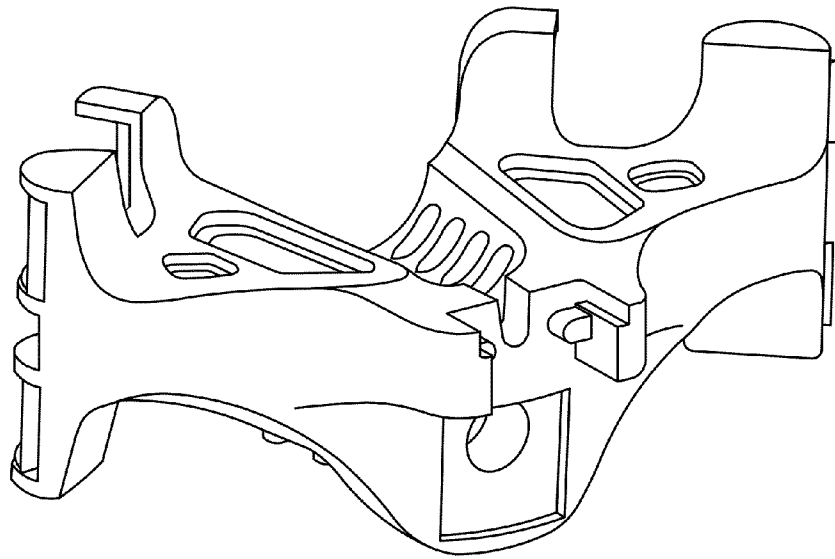

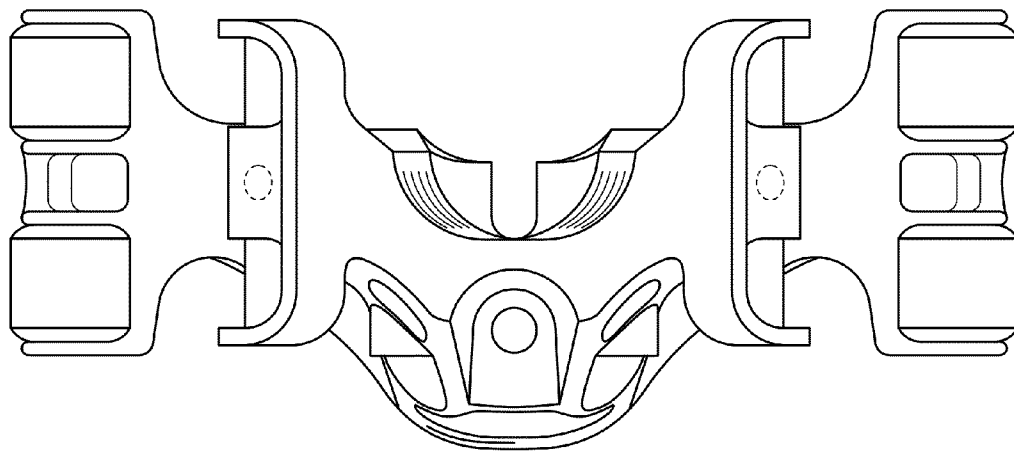

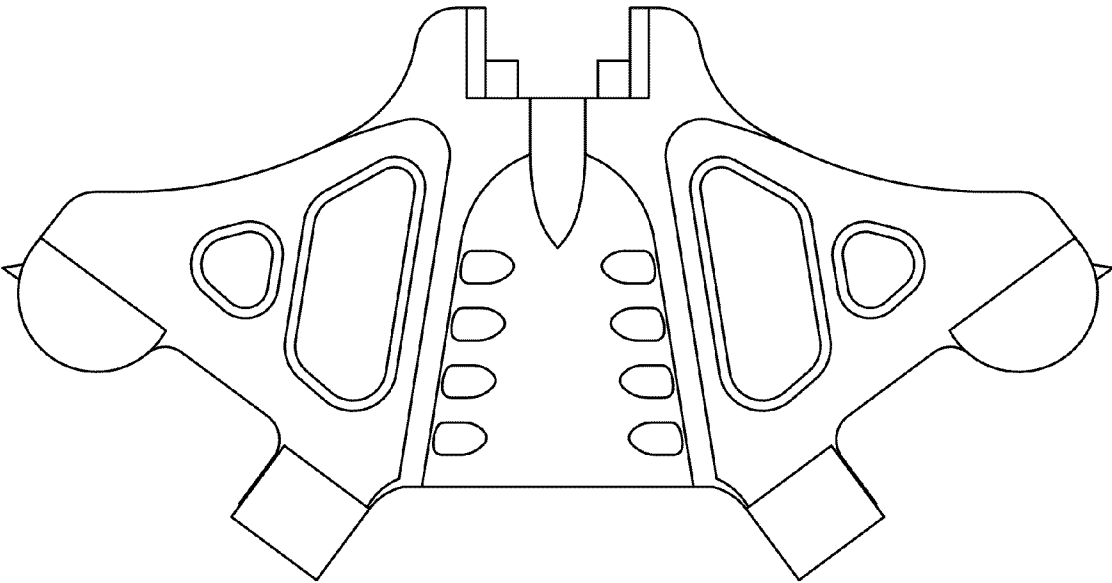

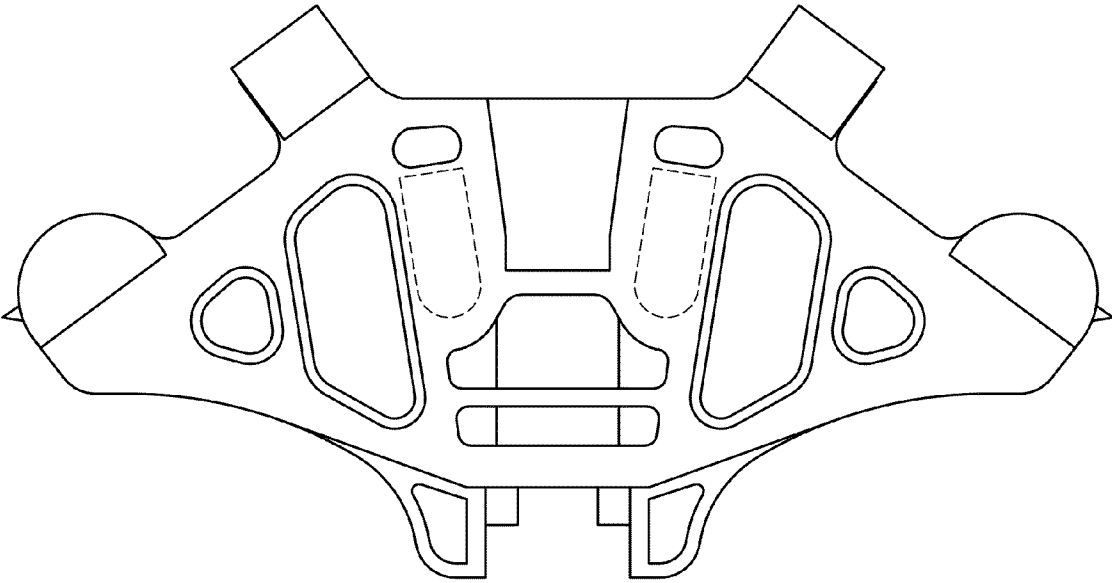

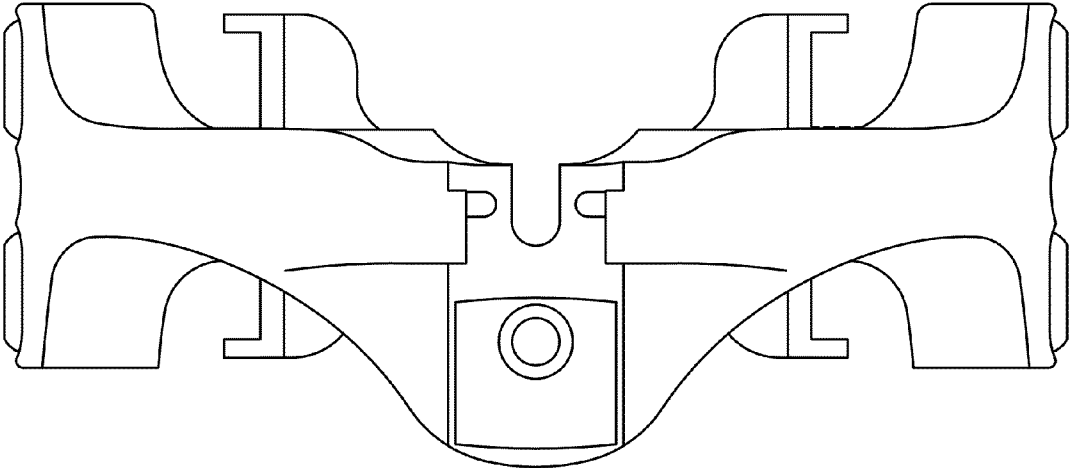

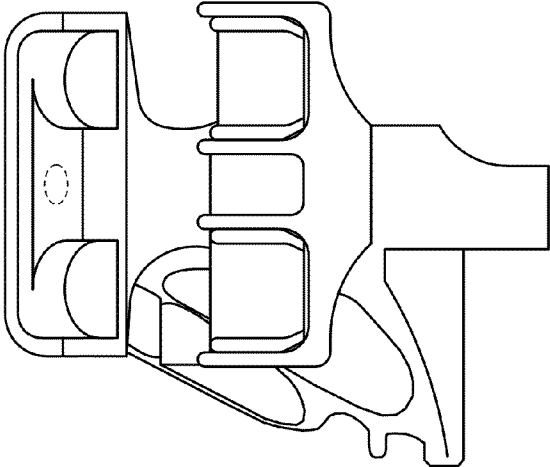
