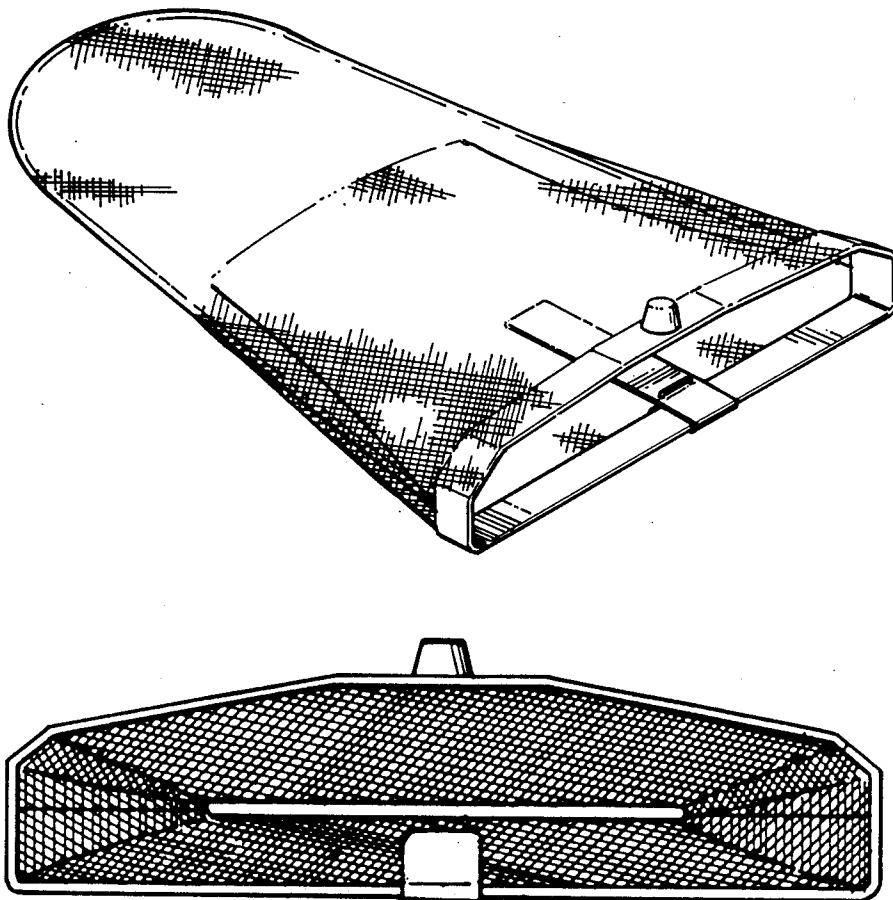

The cross hatching which is partially shown for ease of illustration on the bag in FIGS. 1 and 3 represents a conventional fabric and is understood to cover the entire bag.



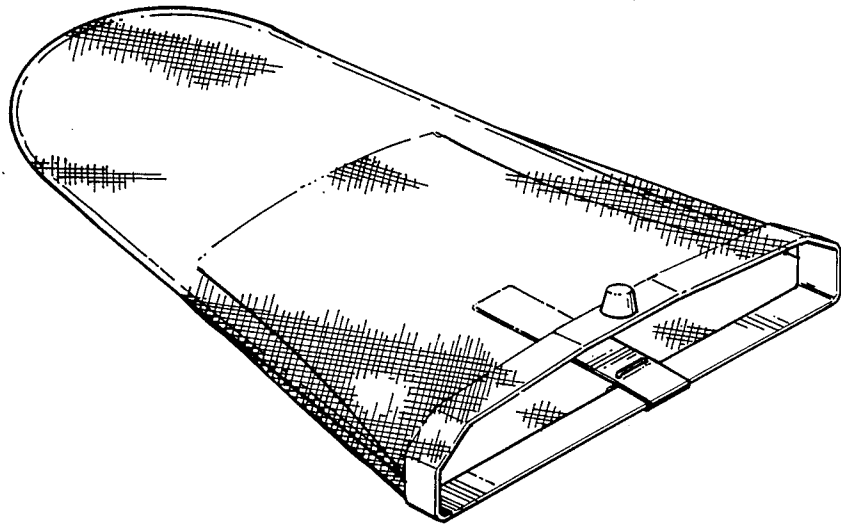

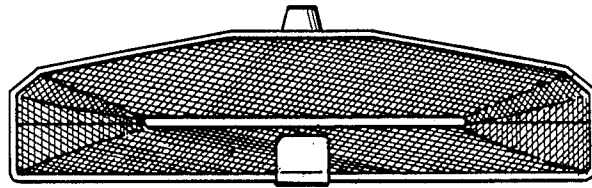

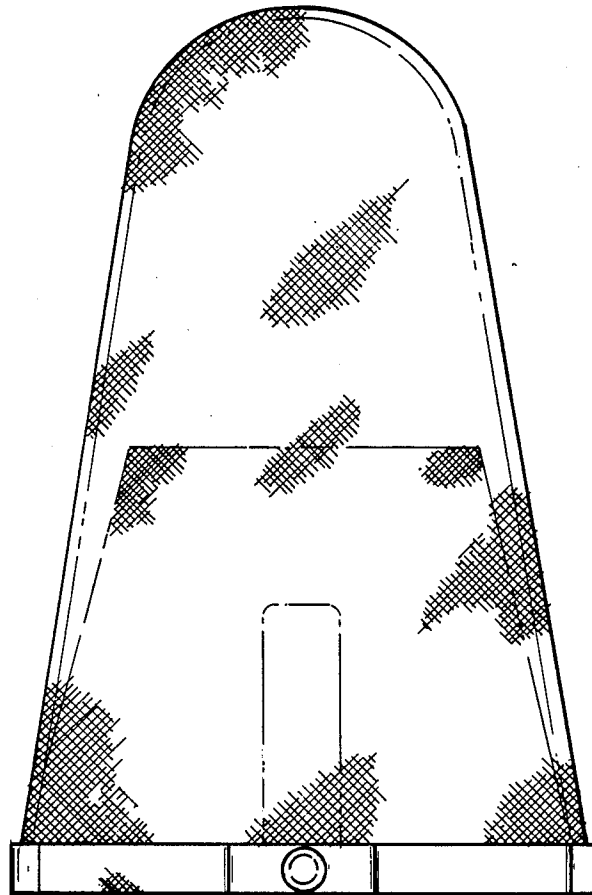
