

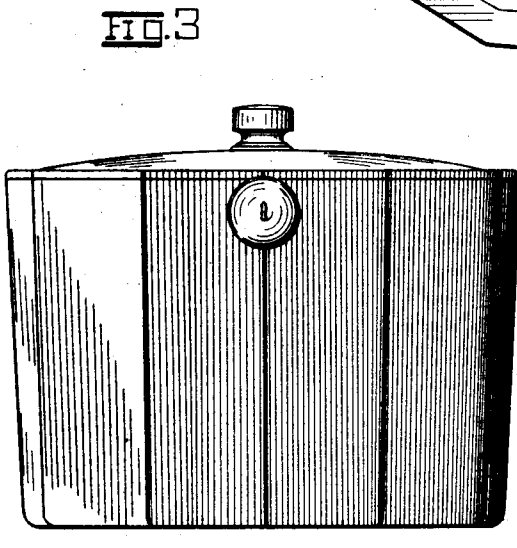
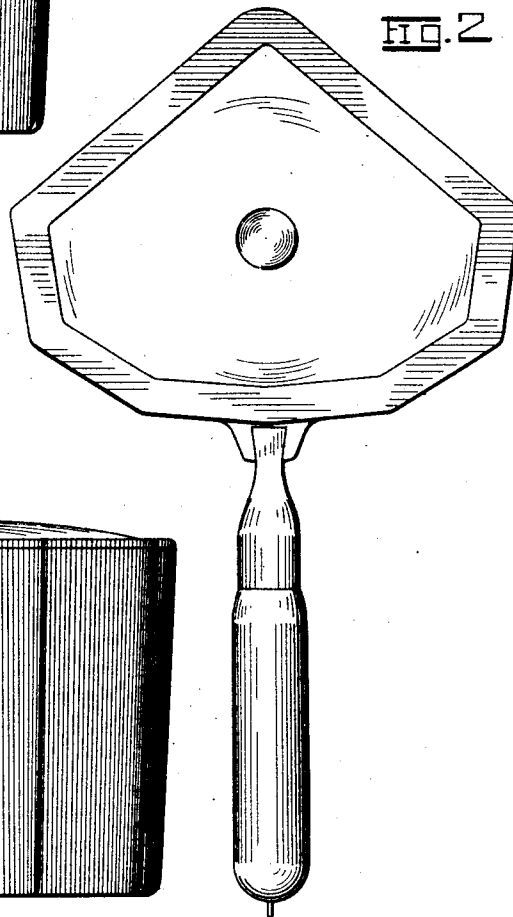
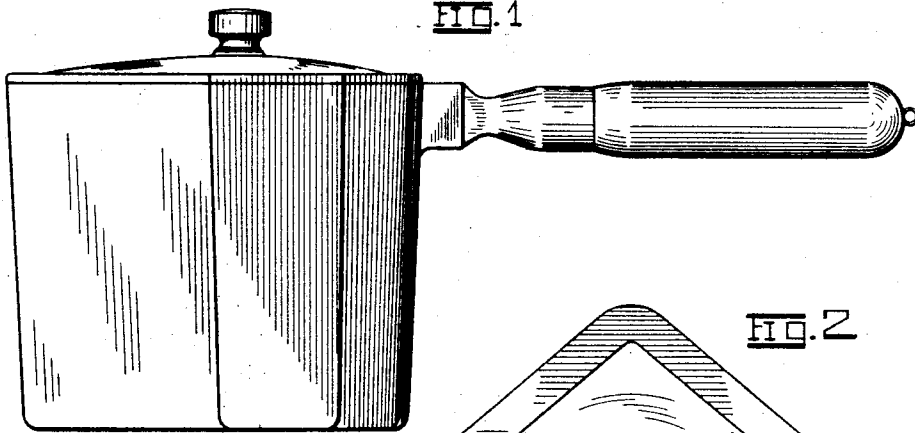

DESIGN FOR A STEWPAN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed March 19, 1927. Serial No. 21,218. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL DACHMAN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Stewpan or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
