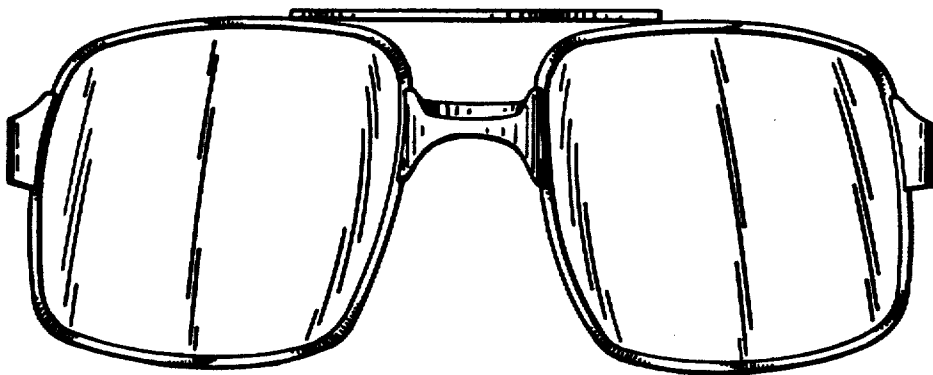

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spectacle frame front, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the spectacle frame front embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one side of the spectacle frame front, the opposite side thereof being of substantially the same appearance; and
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.



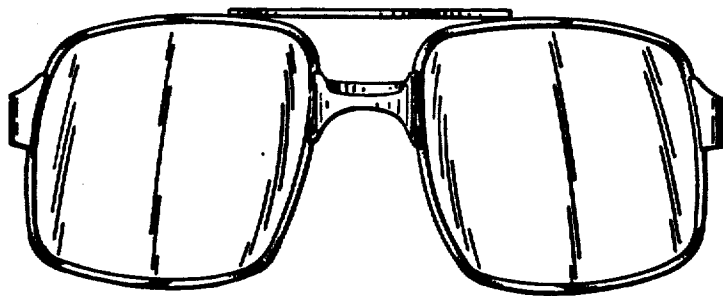
