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
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

(54) Title: APPARATUS AND A METHOD IN THE FIELD OF PHOTOGRAPHY FOR RECORDING AND REPRODUCING SCENT OR TASTE



(57) Abstract: A camera (10) comprising means for capturing an image, integral scent association means operable by a user to associate a scent (26) with the image, and integral means operable to cause the said scent to be perceived by a user. The invention also provides a printer (40) comprising printing means and integral scent generation means, wherein the scent generation means comprise a drive mechanism and a tape having a plurality of scented regions, the drive mechanism being operable to spool the tape and the scent generation means being operable to cause a selected scented region to emit its scent.
