

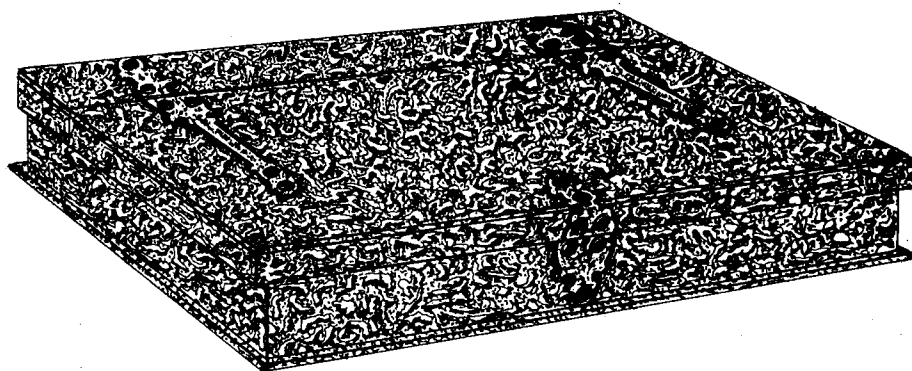

DESIGN FOR A SILVERWARE CHEST

Application filed September 22, 1931. Serial No. 41,182. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE E. HERRING, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Silverware Chest, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
