FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the front panel being unfastened and lifted;
FIG. 4 is an inside elevational view thereof, the garment shown open and spread flat; and,
FIG. 5 is an outside elevational view thereof; the garment shown open and spread flat.
The broken lines shown throughout the views are understood to represent conventional stitching.

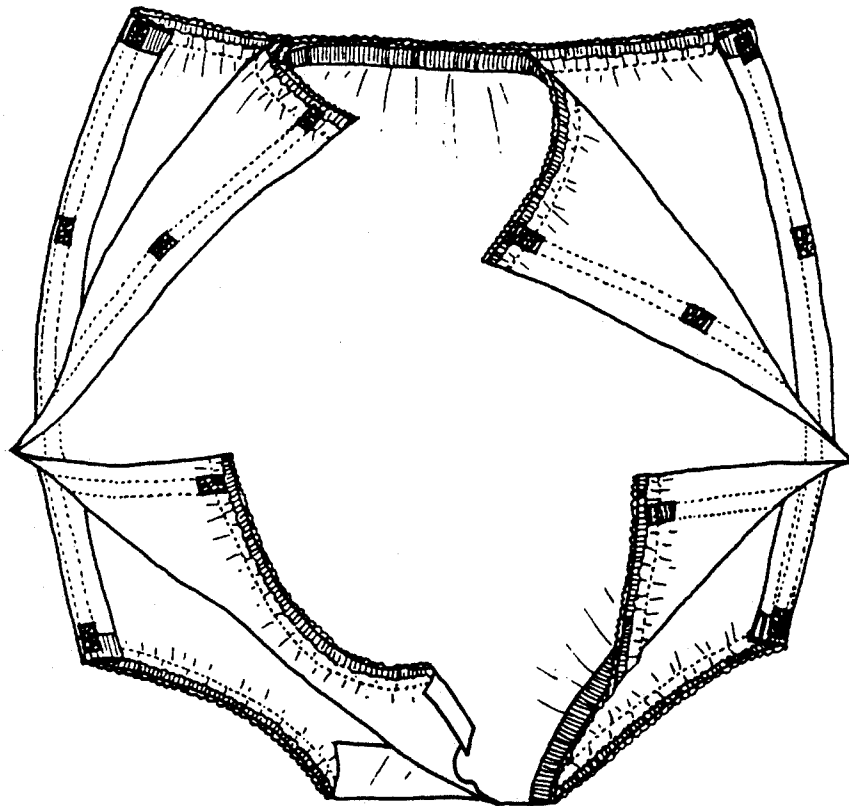

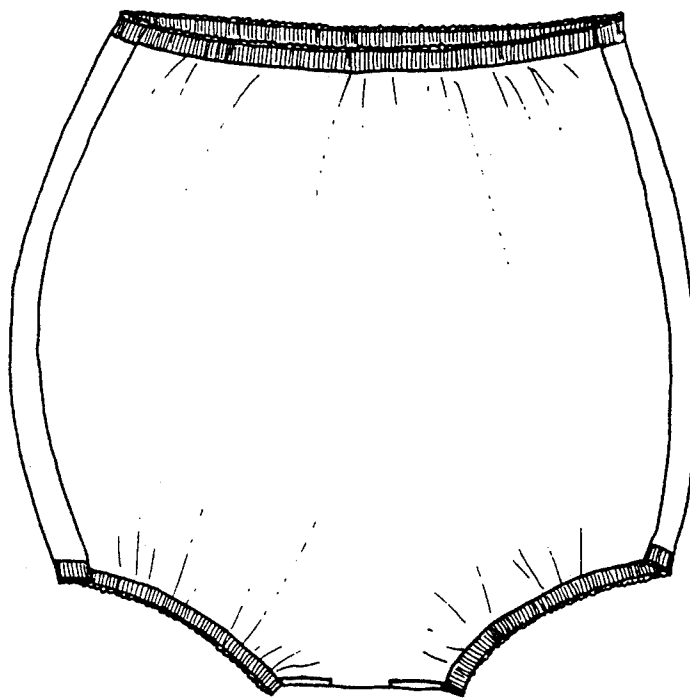
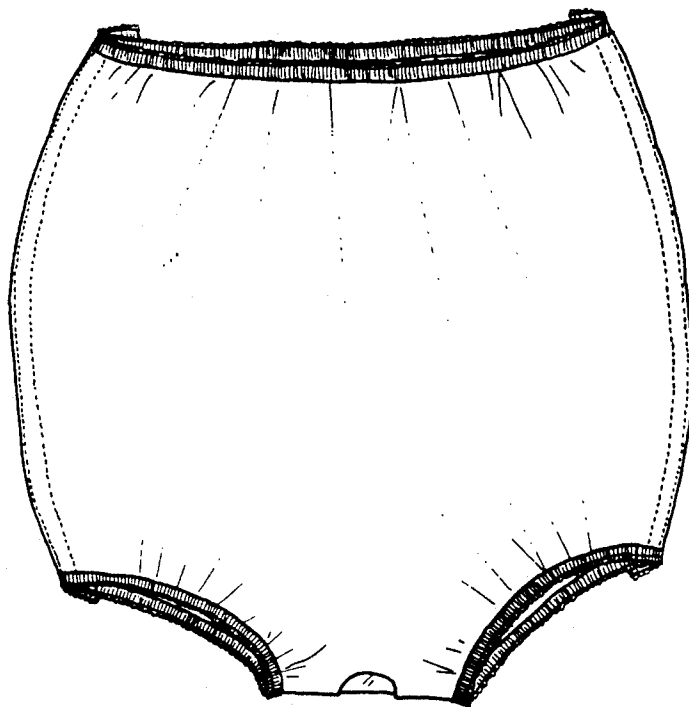

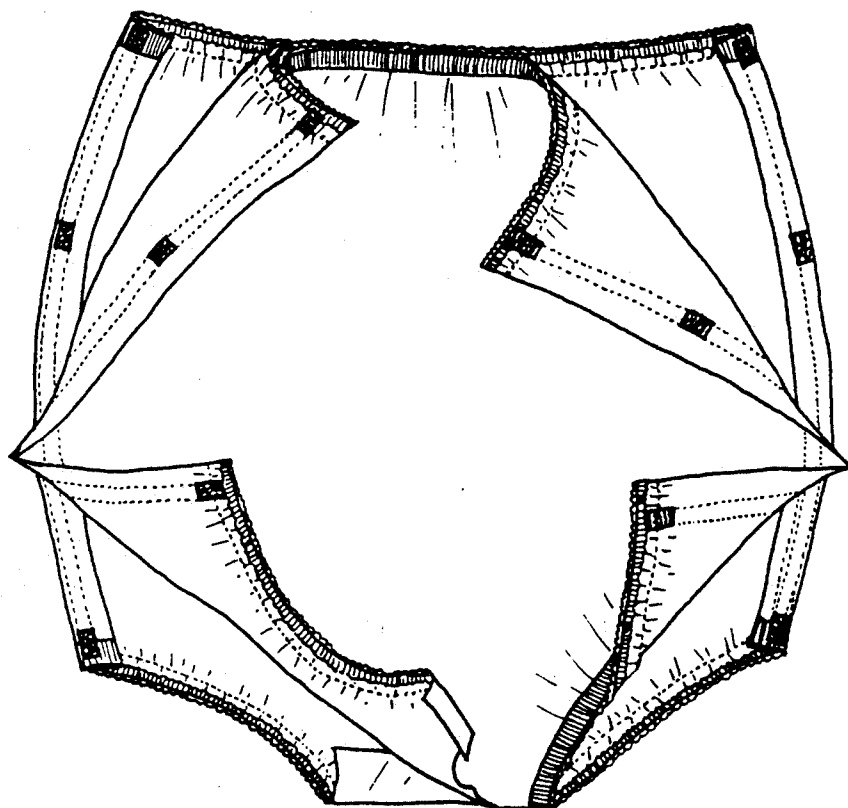

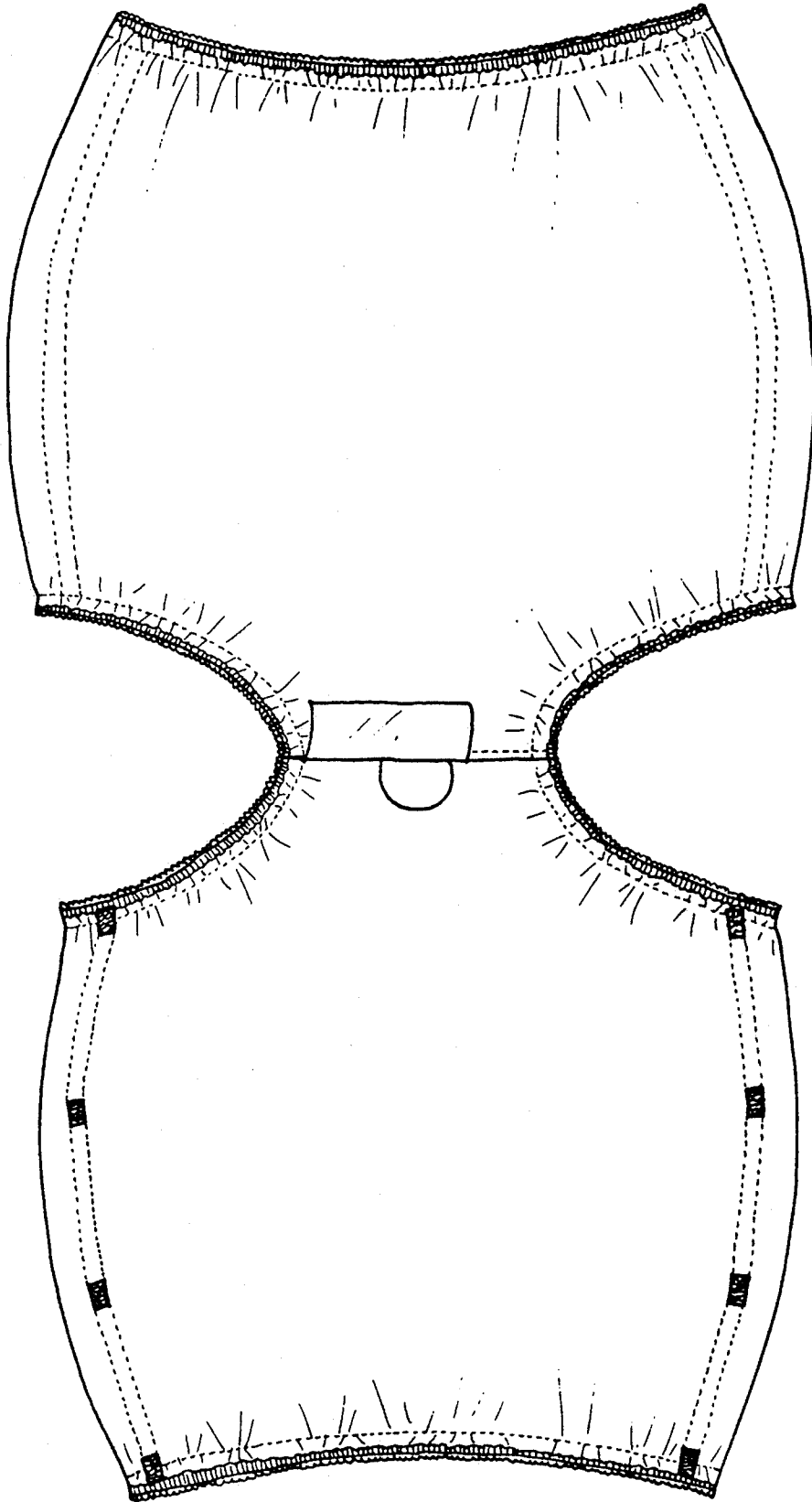

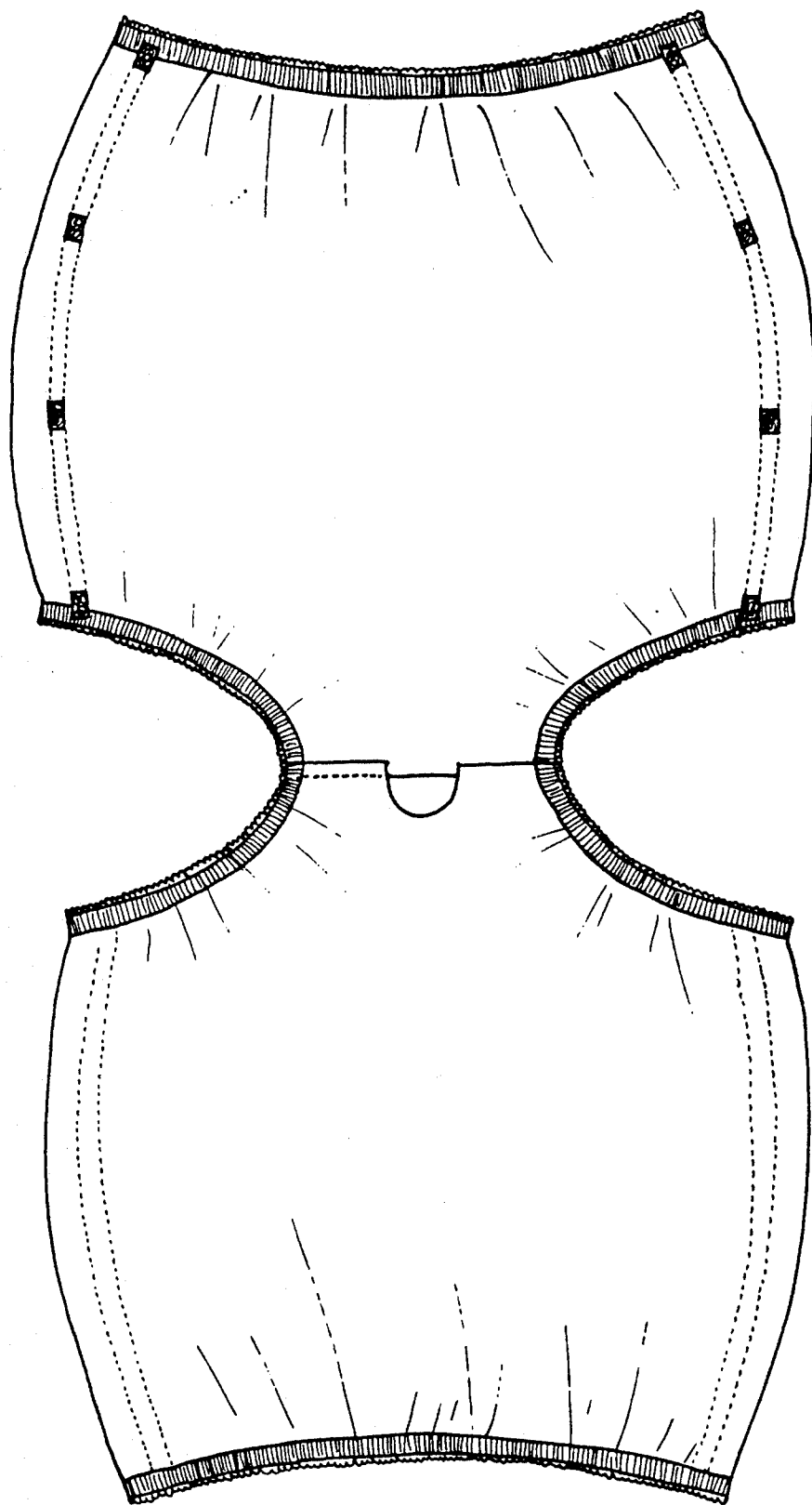
