The ornamental design for a loudspeaker housing, as shown.

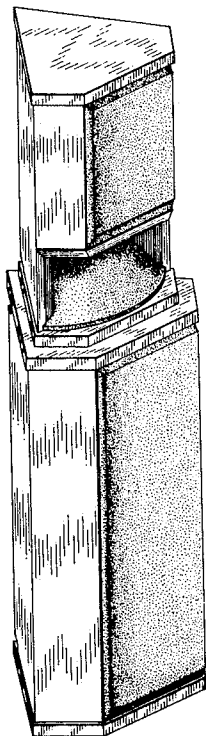
DESCRIPTION

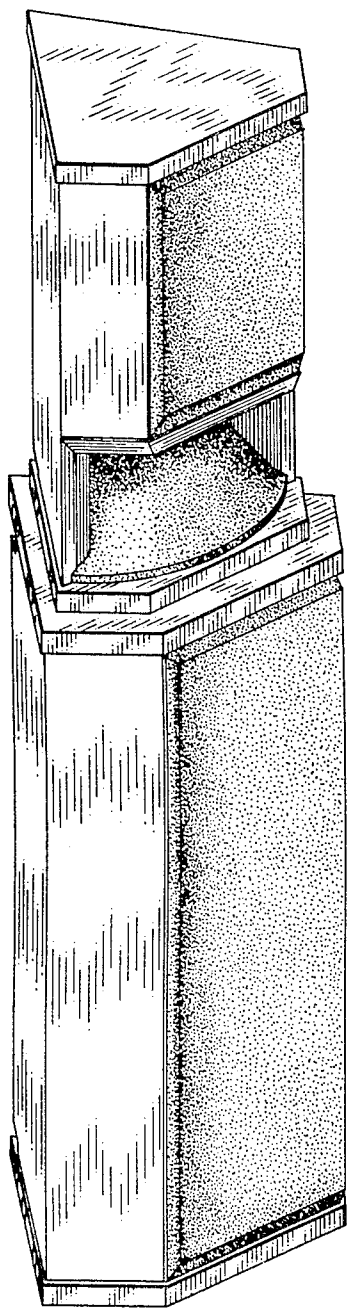

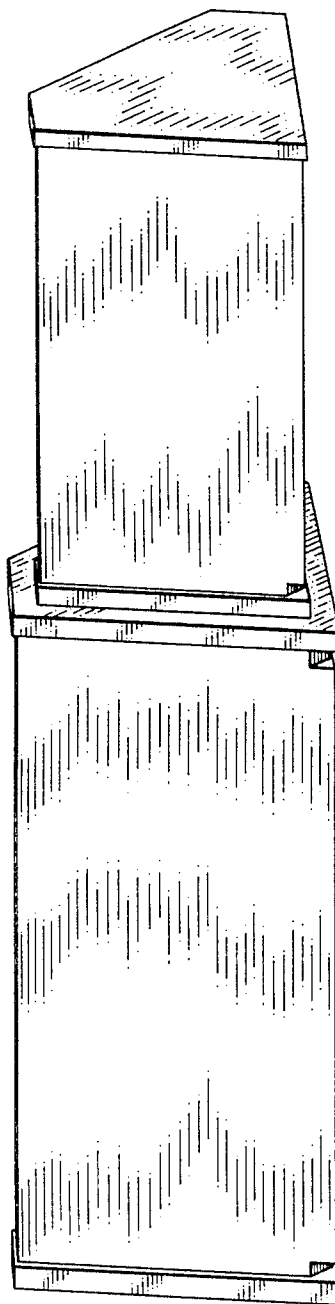
