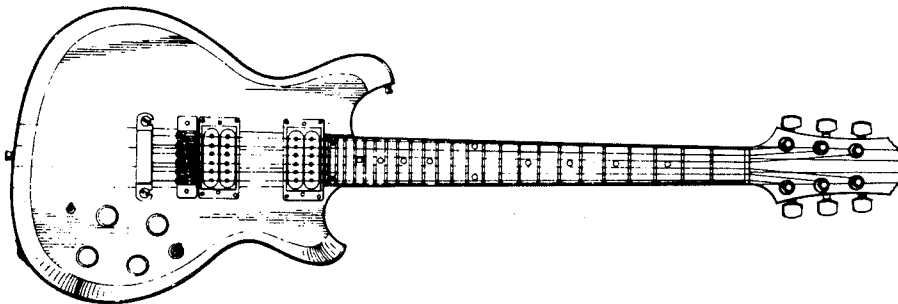

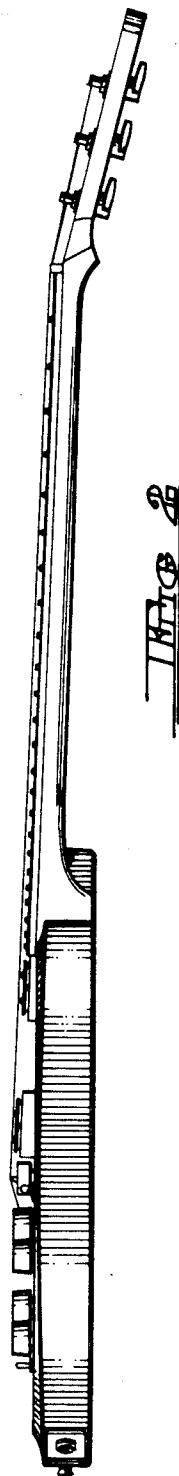
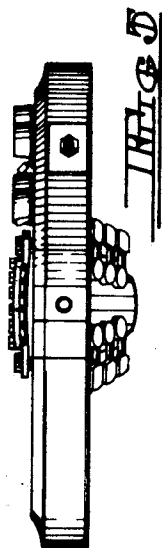
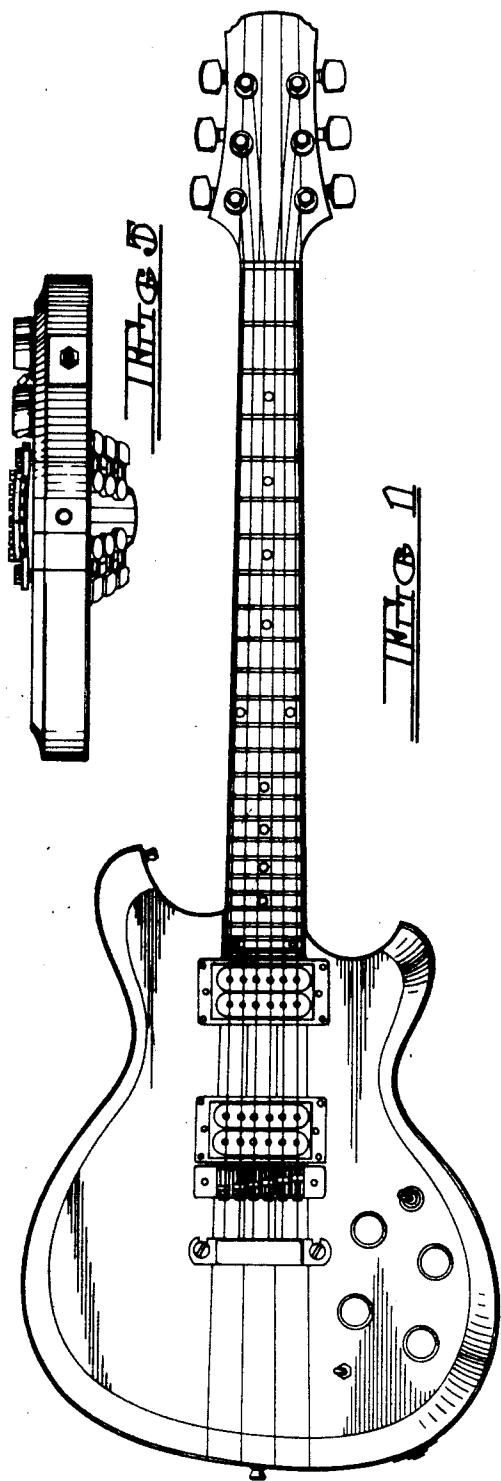
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.





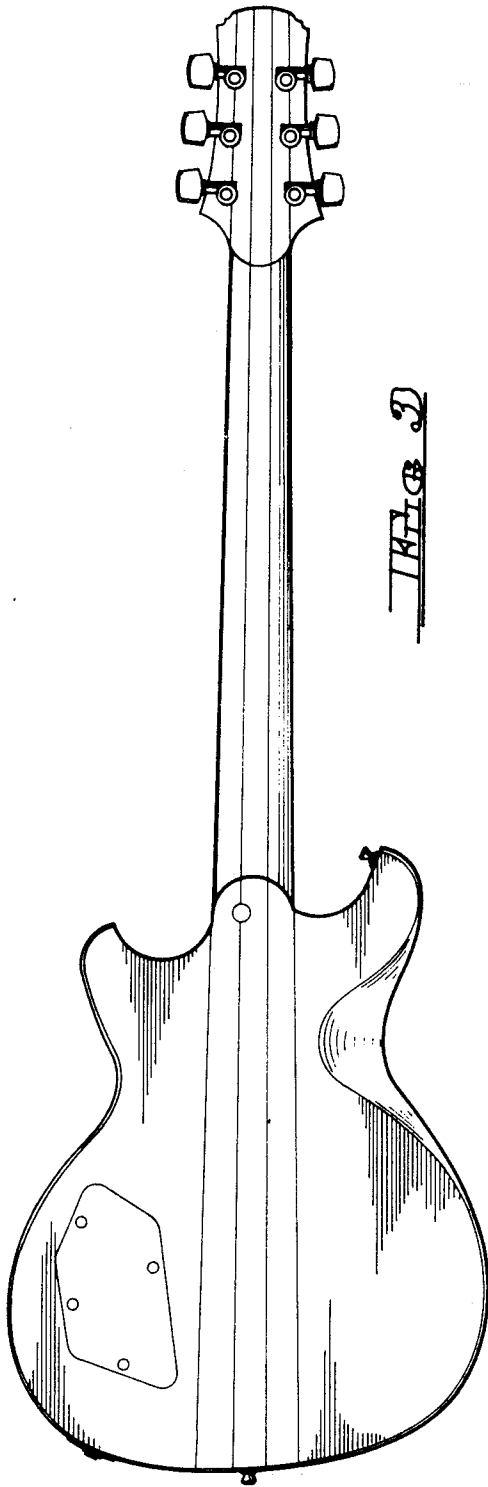
