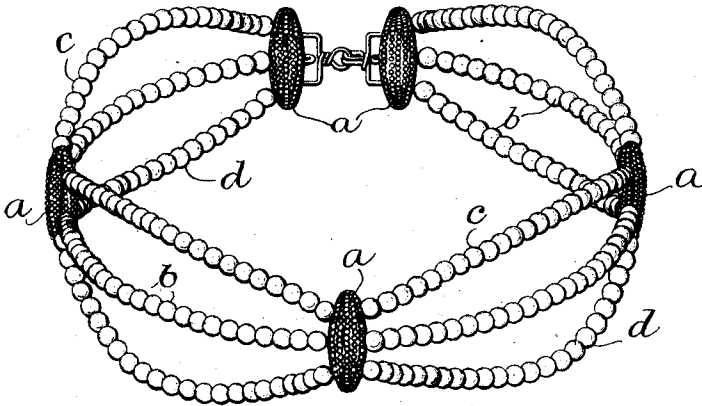

DESIGN FOR A BEAD COLLAR.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARY V. MAAG, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Bead Collars, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The drawing is a perspective of a bead-collar, embodying the new design.

The bead-collar is characterized by a series of large beads or ornaments *a*, two of which are placed at the back of the collar and a

straight row of beads *b* extending between the ornaments *a* and the upper and lower rows of beads *c* and *d*, the central portions of which are spread away from the straight row *b* and the one brought closer together where they join the ornaments *a*.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a bead-collar as shown and described.
