FIG. 2 is an enlarged view of the upper portion of the coin operated entertainment machine bearing the design as shown in FIG. 1.


FIG. **3** is an enlarged view of the central portion of the coin operated entertainment machine bearing the design as shown in FIG. **1**; and,


FIG. 4 is an enlarged view of the lower portion of the coin operated entertainment machine bearing the design as shown in FIG. 1.




