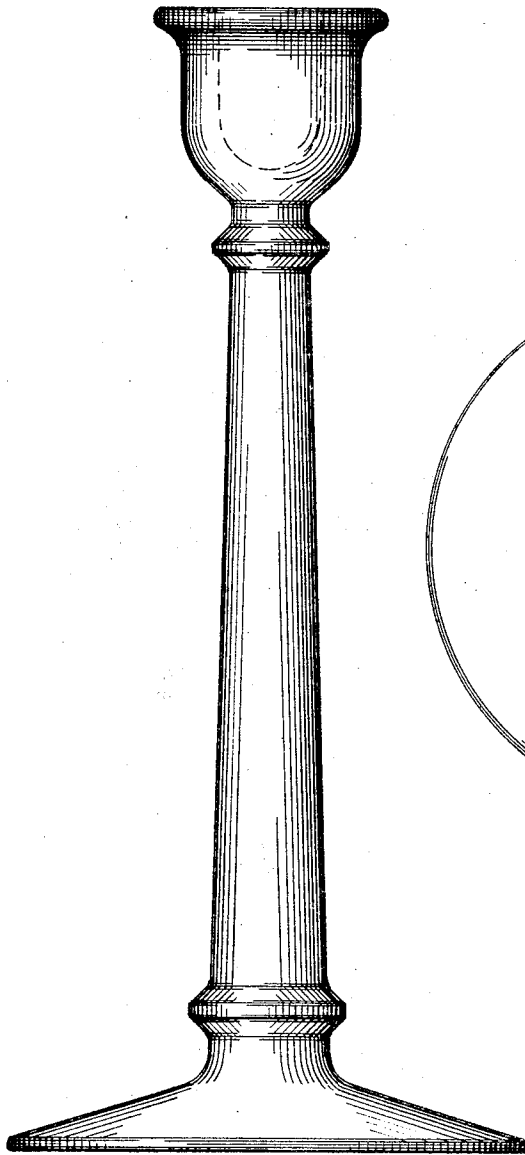
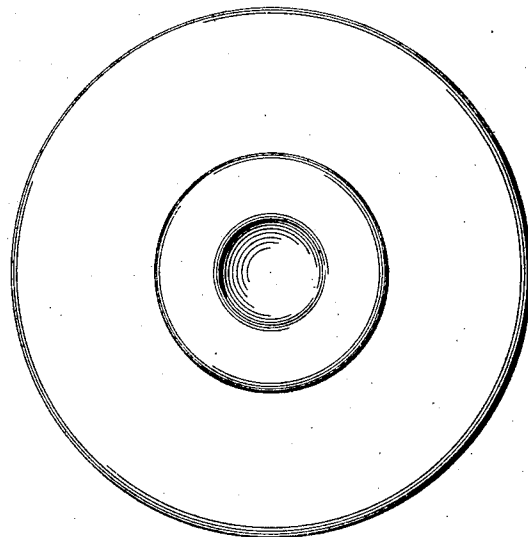

DESIGN FOR A CANDLESTICK.
