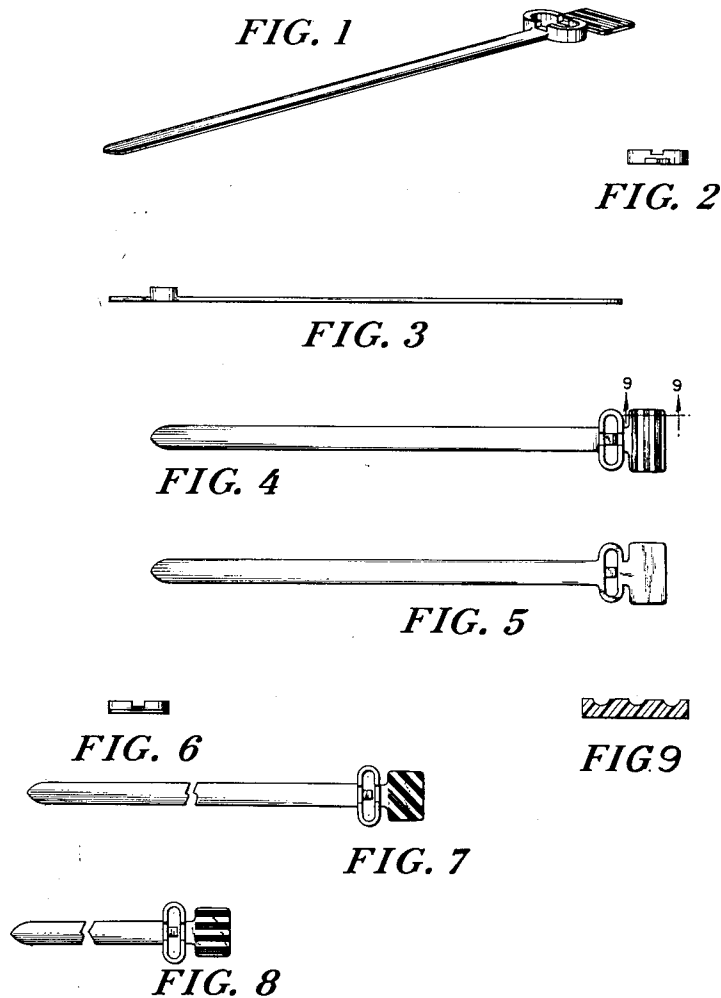


FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bundling strap showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view showing still another embodiment of my new design, with a portion of the strap being broken away for convenience of illustration; and

FIG. 9 is an enlarged sectional view taken on the line 9—9 of FIG. 4.
