

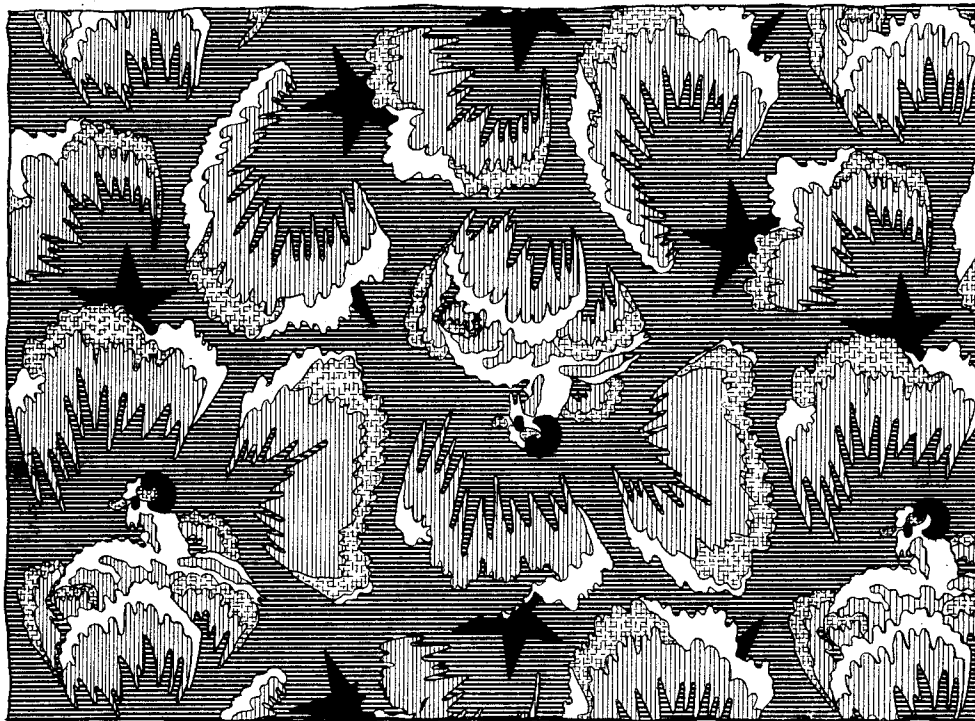

DESIGN FOR TEXTILE FABRIC.
