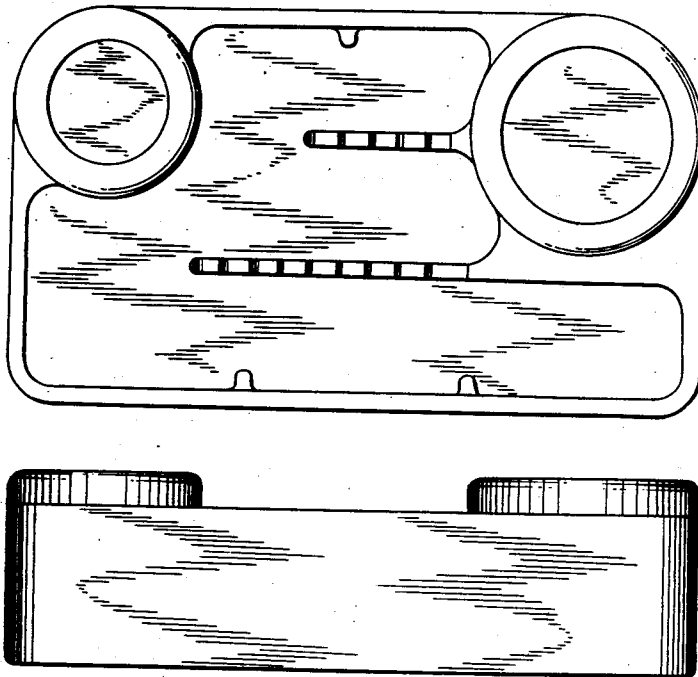

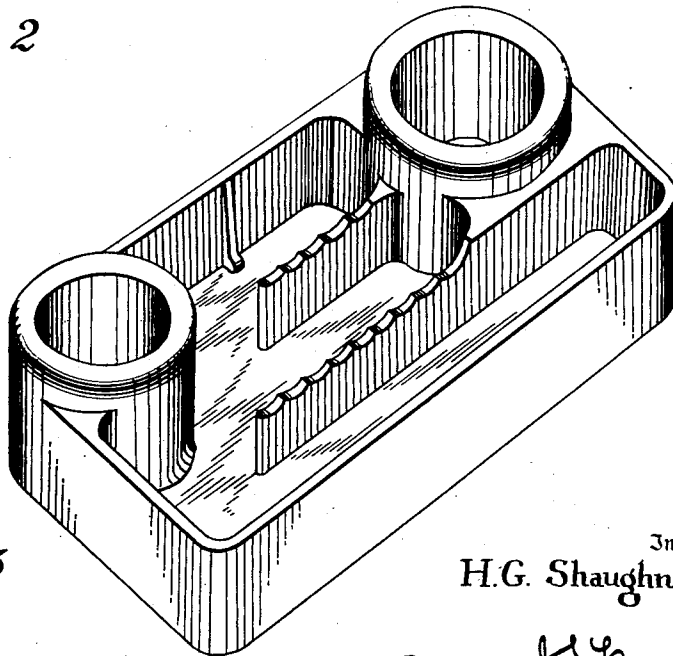

Be it known that I, Harry G.
