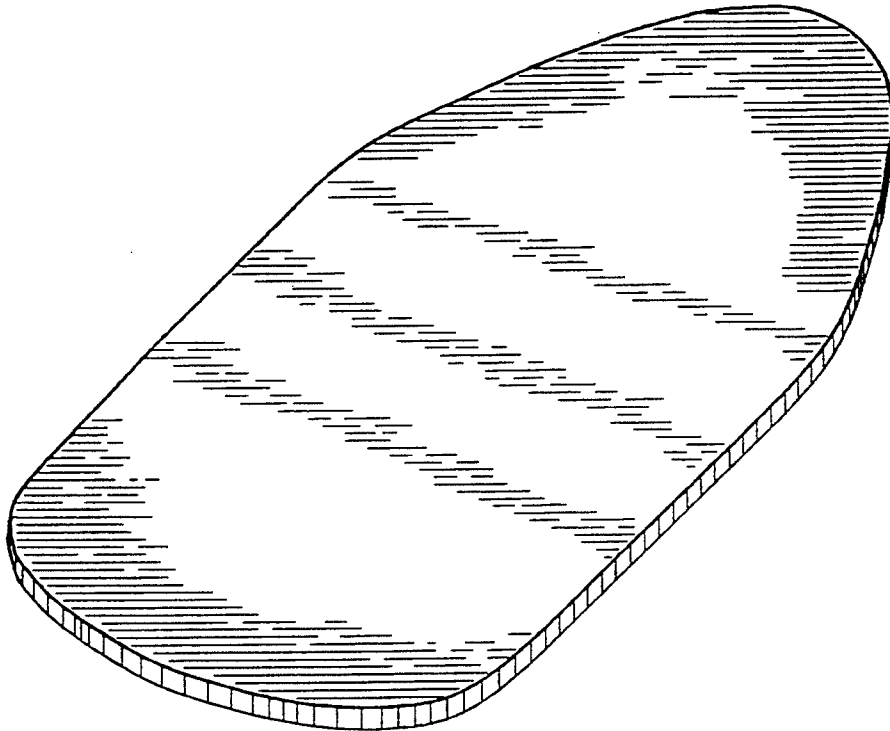

FIG. 4 illustrates a front view of the shoe insole.



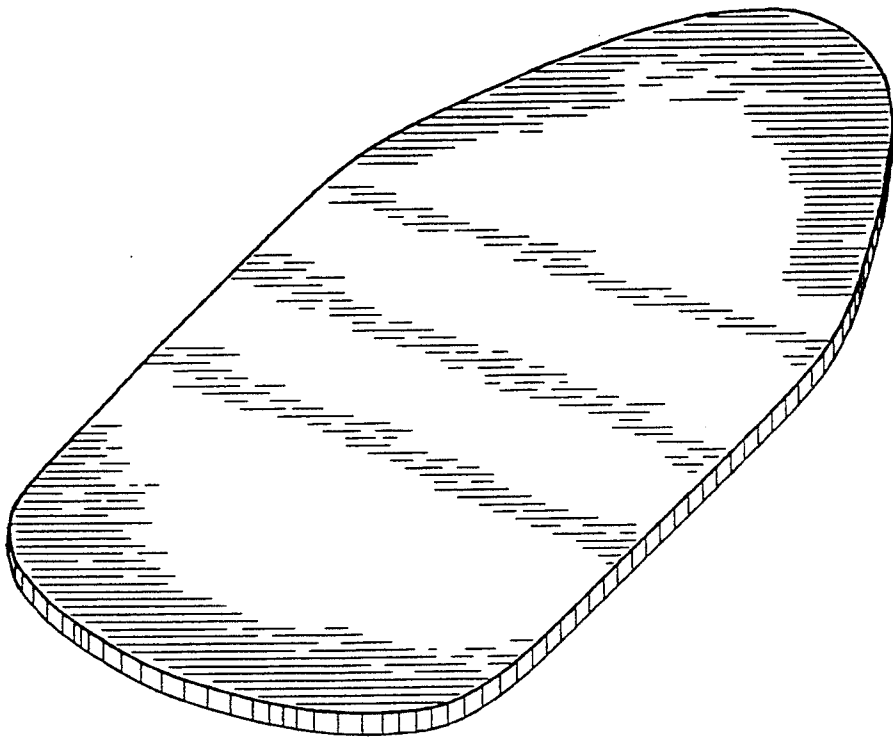

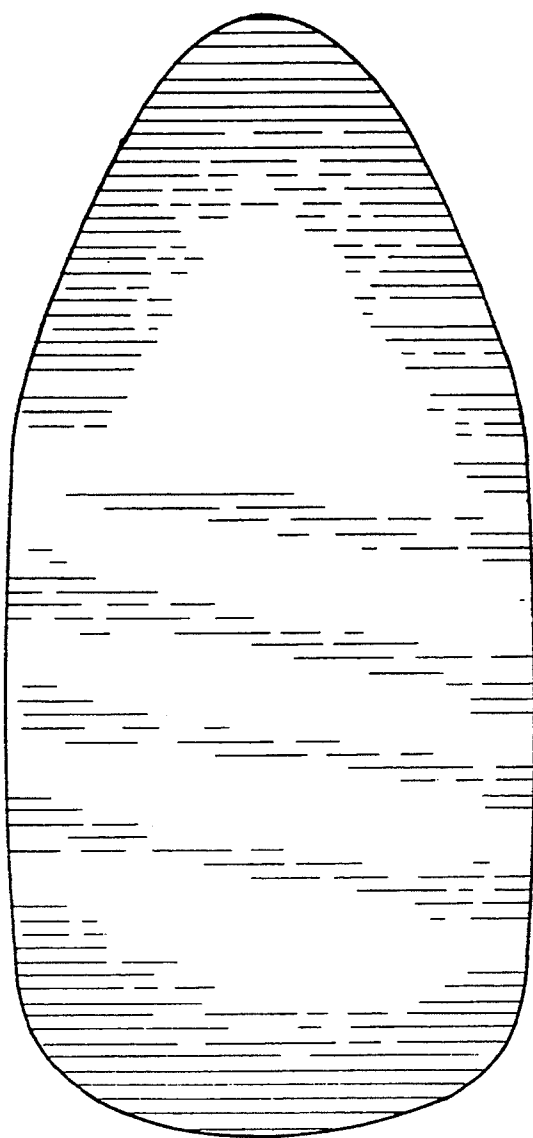
