The ornamental design for a whisk, as shown and described.

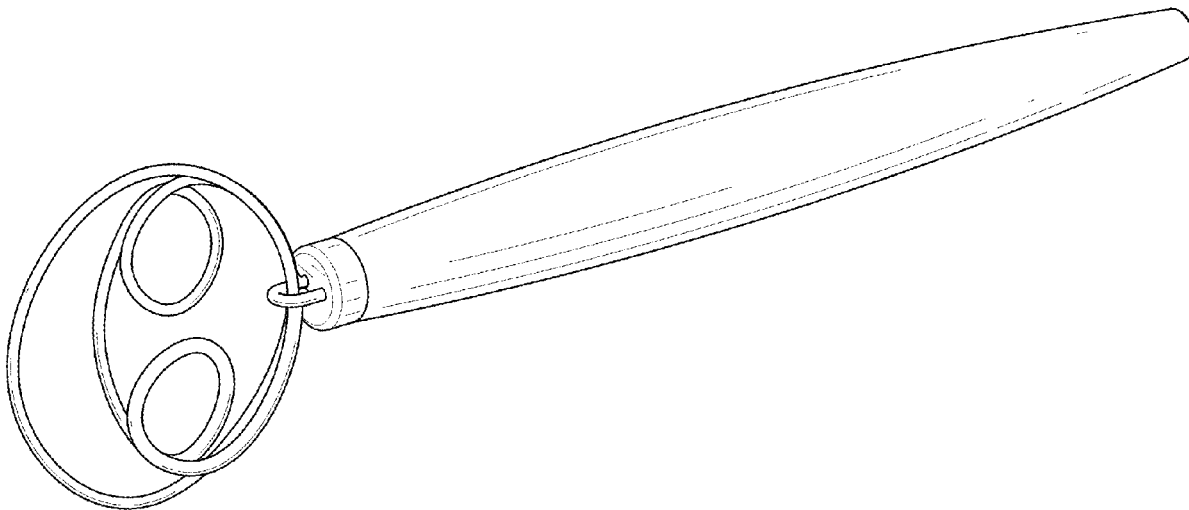
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left side, top perspective view of a whisk showing my new design;

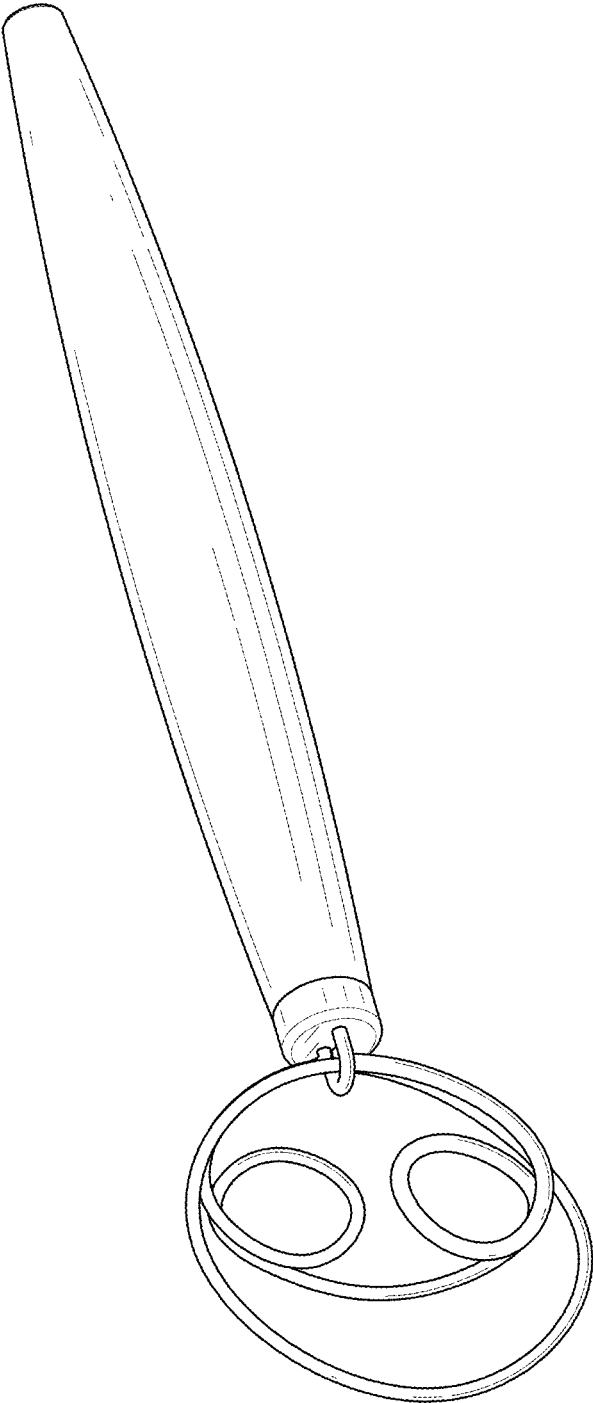

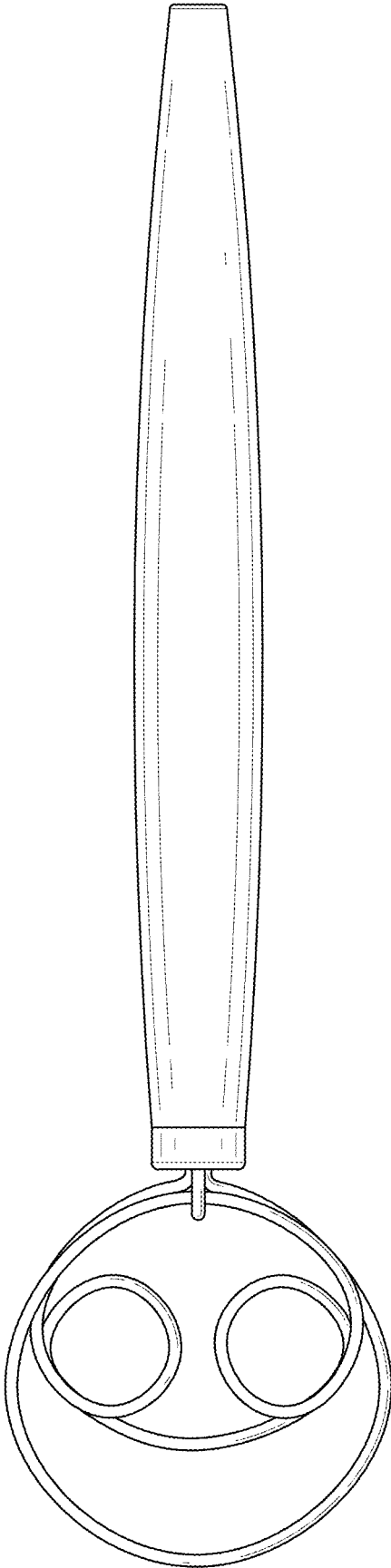

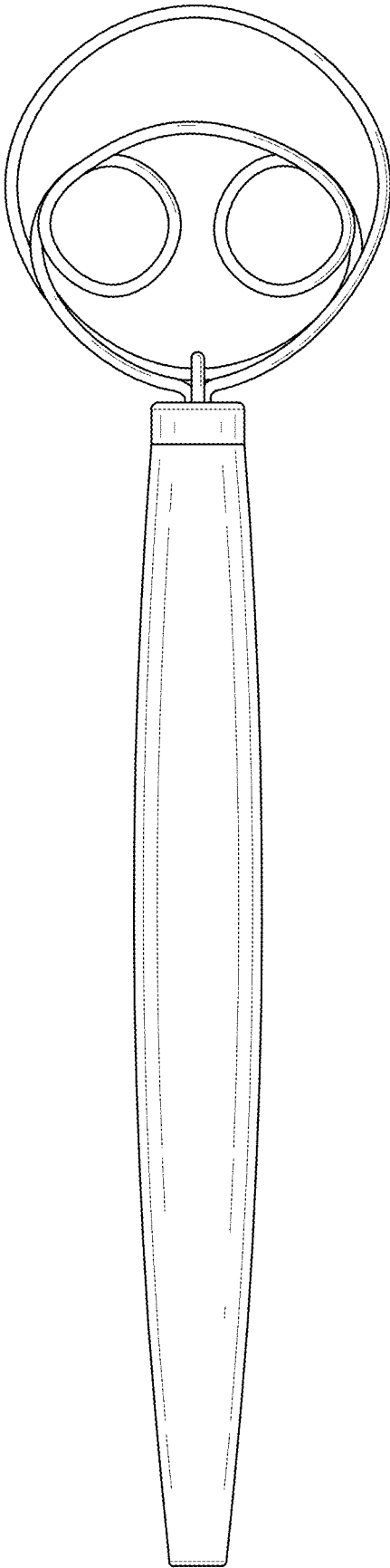

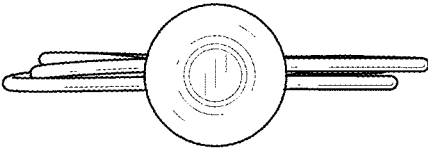

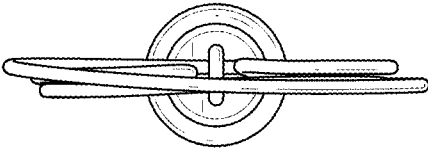
