DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an embodiment of sidewall portion of a lacrosse head showing our design.

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the sidewall portion of a lacrosse head of FIG. 1.


FIG. 6 is a back view of the sidewall portion of a lacrosse head of FIG. 1.


FIG. 7 is a top view of the sidewall portion of a lacrosse head of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the sidewall portion of a lacrosse head of FIG. 1.








