

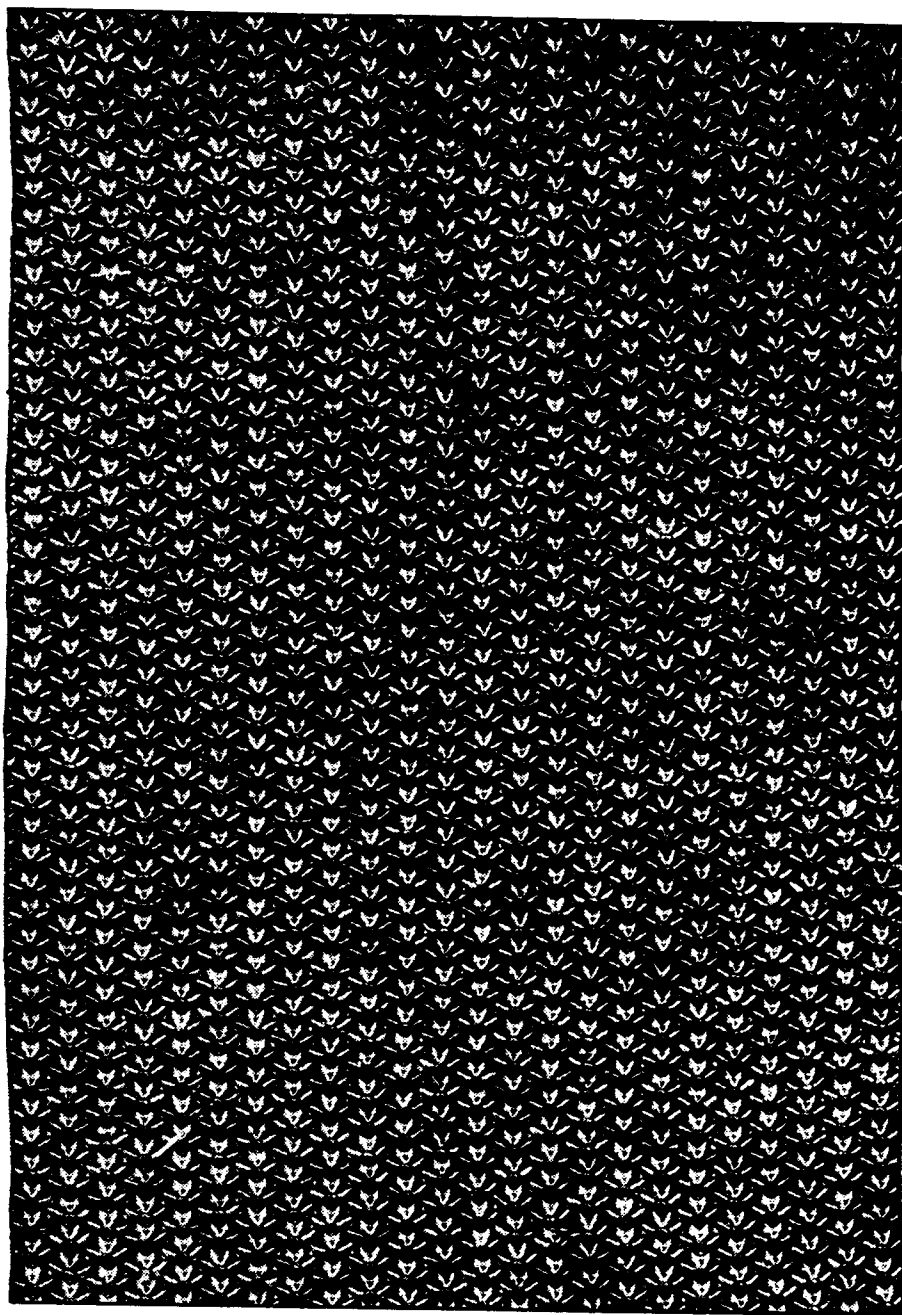

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

Application filed June 12, 1933. Serial No. 48,372. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH PERSKY, a citizen of United States, residing at the city of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric, showing my new design. A single unit of my design is substantially shown on the drawing.
