

(54) Title: MEDICAL DRESSING CONTAINING ANTIMICROBIAL AGENT



(57) Abstract: A medical dressing containing an antimicrobial agent is disclosed. The medical dressing comprises a layered fabric comprising an inner layer (B) of substantially hydrophilic material, an outer layer (A,C) of substantially hydrophobic material on both sides of the inner layer; and an antimicrobial agent. The antimicrobial agent may be releasably impregnated into the fabric, coated on said fabric or a combination thereof. The antimicrobial agent may be a biguanide, such as polyhexamethy-

lene biguanide (PHMB). The fabric inner layer (B) material may be substantially a cellulose fiber, preferably substantially rayon, and the fabric outer layer (A,C) material may be substantially polyester, e.g., a combination of textile matrix grade polyester fiber and amorphous binder grade polyester fiber. The fabric is preferably treated with an aqueous solution of surfactant and PHMB to have about 1500-3500 ppm of extractable PHMB.
