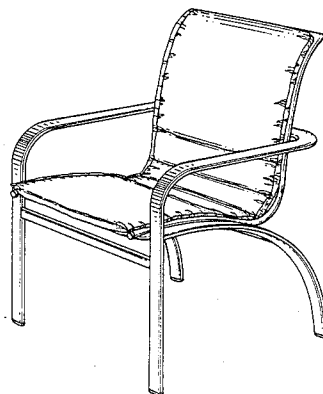

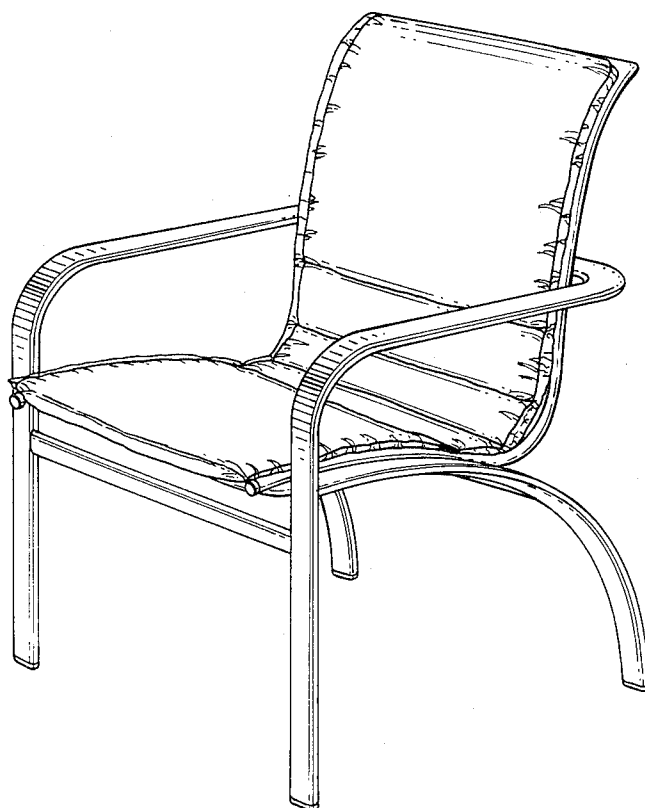
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

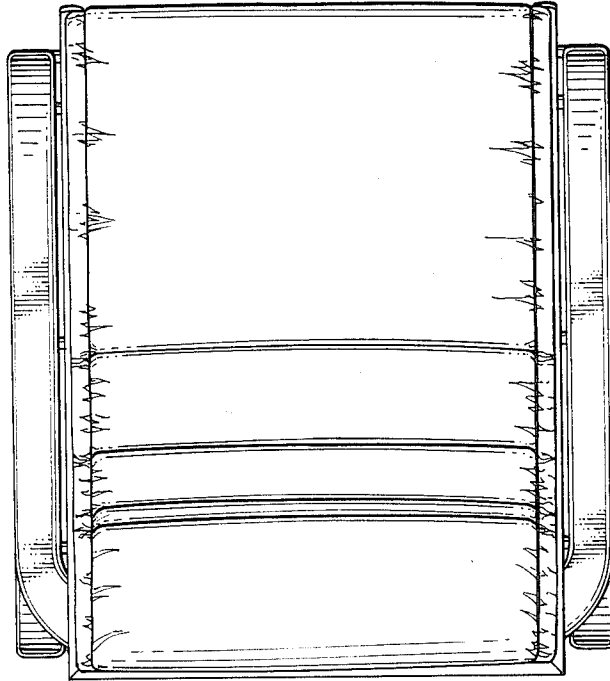
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



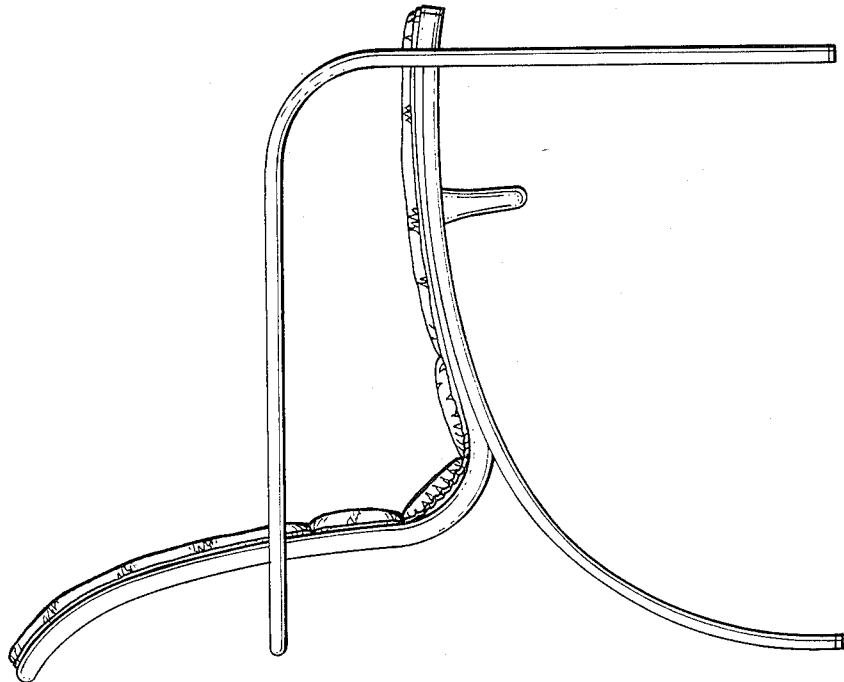

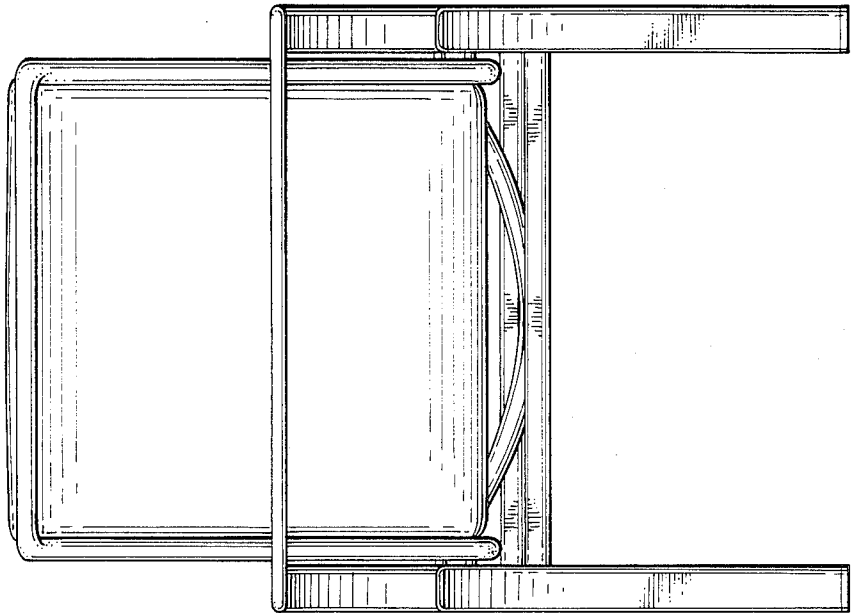
