
In HARRIS COUNTY (county), the extension of FARM TO MARKET ROAD 2100 has been approved for construction on the state highway system. In order to facilitate the flow of traffic, promote public safety and maintain continuity on the state highway system, the county has requested the designation extension of FM 2100 from 2.1 miles north of Wolf Road along Huffman-Cleveland Road to FM 1485.

Pursuant to Texas Transportation Code, §§201.103 and 221.001, the executive director has recommended that FM 2100 be extended along Huffman-Cleveland Road from 2.1 miles north of Wolf Road to the junction of FM 1485.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Texas Transportation Commission that a new location for FARM TO MARKET ROAD 2100 is designated on the state highway system, along Huffman-Cleveland Road from 2.1 miles north of Wolf Road to its junction with FM 1485, a distance of approximately 4.2 miles.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the existing Huffman-Cleveland Road within the above referenced limits will not be designated or incorporated therein prior to the award of the construction contract by the Texas Department of Transportation and that the county will continue to provide maintenance for the county road until construction begins.
