MINUTE ORDER

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District No. VARIOUS (7 & 23)

WHEREAS, in CONCHO AND COLEMAN COUNTIES on FARM TO MARKET ROAD 2134 from near the intersection of the proposed relocation of Farm to Market Road 1929 to Farm to Market Road 503, a distance of approximately 13.3 miles, the relocation of Farm to Market Road 2134 is required because of the construction of Stacy Dam; and

WHEREAS, Minute Order 84021 dated January 30, 1986 authorized the Engineer-Director to proceed with project development to relocate this section of highway with the estimated cost of \$1,200,000 to be financed by the Colorado River Municipal Water District; and

WHEREAS, during the public hearing phase of this project it was determined that the relocation of this highway be to the immediate south of the proposed lake at an estimated cost of \$4,068,000, instead of the originally planned route which was estimated to cost \$1,200,000; and

WHEREAS, the Department recognizes the need to continue with the timely completion of this highway relocation in conjunction with the completion of the proposed Stacy Dam;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Engineer-Director is hereby authorized to proceed in the most feasible and economical manner with project development to include any necessary agreements, right of way acquisition, utility adjustments, relocation assistance and construction at an estimated cost to the State of \$2,868,000.
