
STAR is pleased to present our 2022 Legislative Scorecard to highlight our progress and the leaders who have demonstrated a commitment to improving our laws in the past year.

Since 2014, STAR has worked with Louisiana legislators to improve the rights and protections of sexual trauma survivors and implement prevention initiatives throughout the state to fulfill our mission. Our goal is clear: end sexual violence. While some may think this goal is idealistic, we believe it is possible and will never give up in our pursuit of it.

During the 2022 legislative session, STAR scored twelve bills. These included legislation to provide expungements to survivors of human trafficking when they commit crimes due to their victimization, to permit access to police reports and forensic medical records for survivors, and to mandate hospitals provide survivors with the option of emergency contraception after receiving forensic medical exams.

While we can celebrate many victories, this past legislative session did not result in all wins. Our bill to allow survivors of sexual violence (which included sex trafficking survivors) greater access to civil justice failed in committee after concerns from the Louisiana Association of Business & Industry (LABI). However, during committee, LABI indicated they would be willing work with STAR to find a solution. We recognize that compromises must be made to continue our progress towards our overall goal, while also continuing critical conversations on how justice comes in many forms for survivors.

STAR will continue to celebrate our progress in supporting survivors, improving systems response, and creating social change to ultimately end sexual violence. This scorecard is a testament to the hard work of our staff, community partners, and lawmakers that are making a difference in Louisiana.

Key Bills



Louisiana Legislature, 2022 Regular Session

HB 64 ★

Rep. Mandie Landry, New Orleans, LA

This bill makes technical corrections throughout various statutes to ensure the definition of a child is anyone under the age of 18. STAR supported HB 64.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 313 ★

Rep. Thomas Pressly, Shreveport, LA

This bill amends the Crime Victims Bill of Rights to ensure sexual assault survivors have access to their forensic medical exam reports and other information without redactions of their names or at a cost to them. STAR supported HB 313.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 402 ★

Rep. Jason Hughes, New Orleans, LA

This bill makes technical clarifications in ACT 322 from the 2021 regular legislative session that ended the prescriptive period for civil claims for sexual abuse against minors. STAR supported HB 402.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 431 ★

Rep. Edmond Jordan, Baton Rouge, LA

This bill ensures that DNA collected from sexual assault survivors for rape kits are not entered into CODIS, the DNA database, to be used to match criminal suspect profiles from unsolved crimes. STAR supported HB 431.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 516

Rep. Mandie Landry, New Orleans, LA

This bill requires governing authorities of public high schools to adopt policies on attendance, breastfeeding, and child care for students who are pregnant or parenting.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 561 ★

Rep. Aimee Freeman, New Orleans, LA

This bill provides sexual assault survivors with comprehensive and longer access to civil lawsuits without being blamed for the harm committed against them. STAR supported HB 561.

Status: **Failed in Committee**

HB 615 ★

Rep. Aimee Freeman, New Orleans, LA

This bill provides a pathway for crime victims to access police reports about their victimization after a certain amount of time has passed. STAR supported HB 615.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 1061 ★

Rep. Jason Hughes, New Orleans, LA

This bill ensures sexual assault survivors have access to emergency contraception at hospitals when they receive forensic medical exams. STAR supported HB 402.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

HB 1083

Rep. Candace Newell, New Orleans, LA

This bill would prohibit discrimination in education, employment, public accommodations, and housing based on natural and protective hairstyles. STAR supported HB 1083.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

SB 147 ★

Sen. Beth Mizell, Franklinton, LA

This bill creates the process for adult survivors of sexual assault to access their forensic medical reports. STAR supported SB 147.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

SB 148★

Sen. Beth Mizell, Franklinton, LA

This bill would allow a process for criminal record expungements for survivors of human trafficking when they commit certain offenses directly resulting from their victimization. STAR supported SB 148.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**

SB 255 ★

Sen. Regina Barrow, Baton Rouge, LA

This bill clarifies current law to state that a petition for a protection order should not automatically be deemed "frivolous" just because a survivor did not show up for court. STAR supported SB 255.

Status: **Signed by the Governor**



