## OHIO

### Methodology

Interviews were conducted October 17-20, 2020 among a random sample of 1,102 Ohio voters contacted on landlines (304) and cellphones (798).

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

A subsample of 1,018 has been defined as likely voters (LV), with a margin of error of  $\pm 3$  percentage points.

Telephone numbers were randomly selected from a statewide voter file of registered Ohio voters using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers are proportionally representative to the number of voters in all regions across the state.

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) (formerly known as Anderson Robbins Research) and Shaw & Company Research (R).

### Fox News Poll -- Margin of Error for Subgroups

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). Interviews were conducted by telephone (landline and cellphone) with live interviewers October 17-20, 2020 among a random sample of 1,102 Ohio registered voters and 1,018 likely voters. Results based on the full sample and likely voter sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points.
