Condition

On certain Model S vehicles, either lower rear control arm might crack, causing excessive negative camber of the rear suspension.

Correction

Replace both LH and RH lower rear control arm assemblies with updated parts. Perform an alignment check and, if necessary, adjust.

Procedure

- 1. Replace both the LH and RH lower rear control arm assemblies (refer to Service Manual procedure 31031102).
- 2. Perform a four wheel alignment check (refer to Service Manual procedure 31002100), and, if necessary, adjust (refer to Service Manual procedure 31000100).
