



### The activities of the OSPO






- Centre of knowledge of open source & innersource within Alliander;

  - Which internal projects to actively open source and maintain;
- Enabling cocreation of open source software through collaboration with open source bodies;
- Promoting the use and awareness of open source & innersource software;
- Addressing the risks and importance of compliance within open source software;
- Enabling community meetings if and where possible





    - Business sponsorship' from high level management
    - An enthusiast group of people who have a passion for open source
    - Courage to just start
  - And what helps along the way is
    - 'Ambassadors' in various parts of the organization
    - Knowledge center with Open Source best practices, what to do when starting an Open Source project, Open Source reviewed License list, etc.;
