## Content

The *Discography* covers John Tchicai's recordings 1962 – 2012. Available video recordings are also included.

The *Detailed Listing of Issues* has information on the issues (LP/CD names etc.) – followed by the year of recording.

An overview of some of the most relevant issues is found in the *Selective Listing of Issues*.

LP/CD titles as well as the titles played are generally written with initial capital letters – except for titles in Scandinavian languages.

It has to be remembered that *this discography – like most other discographies – is not faultless!*

The above mentioned listings are separate .pdf documents and the Adobe search functions can therefore be used to locate specific musicians, issues etc.

Two takes were recorded. According to "The John Coltrane Reference" (Vito, Fujioka, Schmaler, Wild and Porter – 2007) "Coltrane chose take 1 (40:31) for release, but take 2 (38:37) was mistakenly released first; take 1 was then issued within a few month in identical packaging (and thus wrong timings on the jacket and labels), the only difference being the identifier "EDITION II" scratched into the wax of the LP itself.".
