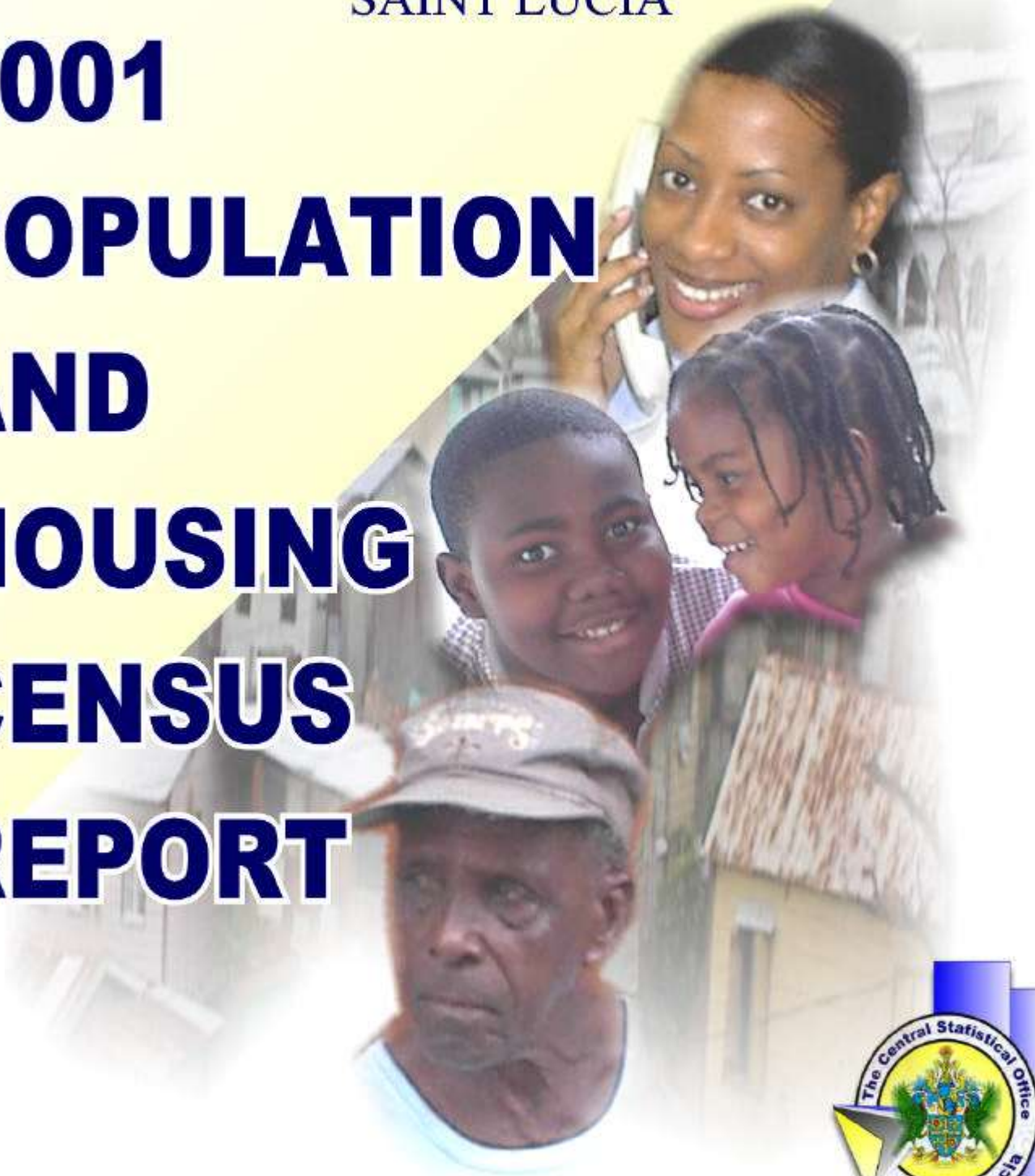

PREFACE

This publication serves as the final of a series of summary reports on the Census of May 2001. We have in this publication made an attempt to identify, as much as possible, all of the social, economic and demographic conditions existing within the population of St. Lucia. With the inclusion of new and established issues related to unemployment, crime, education, religion, the digital divide etc. at the national and administrative district levels we have made an effort to ensure that topics of interest to all are addressed.

During the course of the remainder of this year we will be releasing additional publications designed to address specific issues, including a detailed examination of the population on the basis of gender, which is not fully covered in this publication. In addition we will be releasing an administrative report later in the year designed to serve as a complete documentation of the strategies employed in the execution of the census of May 2001. This will serve to guide the actions taken in the implementation of the census of 2010.

The Census Office of the Statistical Department is very grateful for the assistance of the many enumerators, supervisors, area supervisors, trainers and staff who assisted in the census taking effort. There were many difficulties which we withstood in making the process one which we have confidence is accurate and truly represents a revealing snapshot of St. Lucia, in a social, demographic and economic sense.

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KEY CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Census Day

Census Day was the 22nd May 2001. Census Day provides a reference date for the collection of all data throughout the process of census enumeration. Saint Lucia's 2001 Population and Housing Census counted all persons who were present in the island at midnight of this day.

Enumeration District

An enumeration district (or E.D.) is a defined geographical area comprising approximately one hundred to one hundred and fifty households. To facilitate the collection of census data, Saint Lucia was subdivided into several hundred enumeration districts. This procedure gave enumerators the opportunity to visit all households in Saint Lucia within a reasonable amount of time.

Visitation Record

The visitation record or listing record was designed to monitor field visits during the enumeration phase of the census. It also acts a register of all buildings, dwelling units, households, institutions, businesses and agricultural holdings.

Total Population

Saint Lucia's 2001 Population and Housing Census counted the island's *de facto* population. This means that the census counted the total of all persons who were present in the country at the time of the census.¹ The following is a list of the population groups included in Saint Lucia's total population:

1. Persons living in private households
2. Persons living in non-private dwellings, group dwellings and institutions
3. Persons with no fixed place of abode (socially displaced or homeless)
4. Persons including visitors and crew on vessels in port at the time of the census
5. Foreign military, naval, diplomatic personnel and their respective families present in the country at the time of census
6. Persons living on offshore islands which are geographically part of Saint Lucia

¹ Some population censuses count all usual residents of a particular country. In this instance the total population is referred to as the de jure population.

Enumerated Population VS Estimated Population

The enumerated population is the sum of all persons registered on visitation records and/or census questionnaires, while the estimated population is the enumerated population plus an estimate of persons who belong to existing households but who could not be contacted/counted throughout the process of census enumeration.

Household Population

The household population includes all persons who reside in private households in Saint Lucia.

Non-Private Dwellings / Group Dwellings / Institutions

An institution is defined as living quarters in which the occupants live collectively for disciplinary, health, educational, religious, military, work or other reasons.

These institutions have been divided into two major groups:

Group A: includes institutions such as hotels and large boarding houses which cater for six (6) or more paying guests, hostels, military barracks etc., the inhabitants of which, like the general non-institutional population, may engage in normal economic activity. Youth Development and Apprenticeship Centres and juvenile correctional institutions are also included under Group A.

Group B: includes hospitals, nursing homes, prisons, geriatric homes and such institutions where inmates, during the period that they are in the institution, will in general not take part in any normal economic activity. The Institutional questionnaire should be completed for these persons.

Inmates in institutions falling in Group B are included in the Census for Economic Activity if as at Census Day, they would have been inmates in the institutions for less than six months. This information is to be collected from the household in which they normally reside.

Building

A building is defined as a physical structure which is separate and independent of any other, comprising one or more rooms, or other spaces, covered by a roof and enclosed within external walls or dividing walls which extend from the foundation to the roof and is designed for residential, agricultural, commercial, industrial or cultural purposes, or for the provision of services. For example, a building may be a factory, shop, detached dwelling, apartment, warehouse, repair shop etc.

Detached rooms relating to the main building are treated as part of the main building, for example, detached kitchens, toilets, domestic employees' quarters etc.

Dwelling Unit

A dwelling unit is any building or separate and independent part of a building in which a person or group of persons (private household) are living at the time of the census enumeration. The essential features of a dwelling unit are "separateness" and "independence".

An enclosure is separate if surrounded by walls or some form of partitioning, covered by a roof so that a person or group of persons, can isolate himself/themselves from other persons for purposes of sleeping, preparing and sharing meals etc.

It is independent when it has direct access from the street or common landing, staircase, passage or gallery, when occupants can come in and go out without passing through anyone else's living quarters.

Examples of dwelling units are:

- (i) Separate Houses
- (ii) Flats/Apartments
- (iii) Townhouses
- (iv) Barracks
- (v) Part of Commercial Buildings
- (vi) Group Dwelling (institution, hotel, Youth Development and Apprenticeship Centre, and boarding house).

The key concept for a dwelling unit is separateness and independence. Occupants of a dwelling unit must have free access to the street by their own separate and independent entrance without passing through another household's living quarters.

Closed Dwelling Unit

A closed dwelling unit is one, which is occupied, but during the enumeration period the occupants are temporarily away, that is, away for less than six (6) months.

Vacant Dwelling Unit

A vacant dwelling is defined as living quarters, which is habitable, but no one lived there during census enumeration.

Private Dwelling

Private-type dwellings are those in which private households reside. Examples are single houses, flats, apartments, and part of commercial buildings and boarding houses catering for less than six (6) persons.

Household

A private household is defined as one or more persons living together and sharing at least one of the main daily meals. Traditionally, a household will usually comprise a father, mother and children living together.

It is important to note, however, a member of the household is not necessarily a relative of the main family. For example, a boarder or a domestic employee who sleeps in most nights of the week and shares at least one of the daily meals is also included as a member of the household.

The concept of the household and family is not the same. It is possible to encounter more than one family constituting a single household once they share common living arrangements.

Head of Household

For census purposes every household must have a head. The head of the household is the person, male or female, who carries the main responsibility in the affairs of the household.

INTRODUCTION

The information provided herein is ‘final’ insofar as it represents the figures obtained after a substantial ‘clean up’ of the initial 2001 census results. The data cleaning process employed a multifaceted approach of electronic verification, eradication of duplicates and amendment of critical variables and data links, ensuring, for instance, that all persons belonged to a household and had an age and gender and that all dwellings were linked to a specific settlement.

As with the previous census report, the comparisons made between the 2001 and 1991 census figures may be affected by definitional and other analytical variations. Therefore users of this information should explore the related tables accordingly.

The differences in definition among such terms as “Enumerated Population”, “Estimated Population” and “Household Population” must also be taken into account. Note that the enumerated population is the sum of all persons recorded on visitation records and/or census questionnaires, while the estimated population is the enumerated population plus an estimate of persons who belong to existing households but who could not be contacted/counted throughout the process of census enumeration. The household population includes all persons who reside in private households in Saint Lucia.

THE POPULATION SIZE AND DENSITY

The preliminary count of Saint Lucia’s enumerated population as at midnight on Census Day, the 22nd May 2001, indicated a total of 156,635 persons. This total comprised of 77,664 males and 78,971 females. Out of this sum, there were 151,143 individuals residing in private households, 586 persons living in institutions and 4,906 guests in hotels or guesthouses.

An estimate of persons who were not counted during the census’ enumeration phase was added to the enumerated household population to produce an estimated household population of 157,490 people. This total compared to the 1991 Census’ enumerated household population of 133,308 indicates an overall household population percentage increase of 18.1 percent.

Out of the ten districts in Saint Lucia, household population contractions were reported in the districts of Canaries, Soufriere, Choiseul and Laborie. Choiseul recorded the largest household population decrease. See Table 7.

¹ In this report, growth rates, percentage changes and household sizes were all calculated using the estimates of the household population presented in this publication.

Census 2001 estimates show that Saint Lucia's island wide population density is 757 persons per square mile (Table 8B). This figure was calculated using a land area of 208 square miles that excludes Saint Lucia's forest reserve areas. These forest reserve areas cover approximately 30 square miles. The district of Castries, the location of Saint Lucia's capital city, had a population density of 1,998 persons per square mile. The least densely populated district, with a population density of 376 persons per square mile, was the district of Soufriere. The district of Gros Islet, which reportedly experienced the most rapid population expansion, recorded a population density of 505 individuals per square mile. In 1991, census figures reported a population density of 345 persons per square mile in the district of Gros Islet. Gros Islet was the least densely populated district in Saint Lucia at that time.

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTIONS & POPULATION GROWTH

For Census 2001, most of Saint Lucia's enumerated population resides in the suburban areas of the district of Castries. Approximately 17 percent of Census 2001's enumerated population lives in suburban Castries. This percentage represents 27,329 persons. Rural Castries, with a population share of 15 percent, was the next most populated area; while the district of Gros Islet was the third most populated with a population share of 13 percent. The least populated area of Saint Lucia in 2001 was the district of Canaries. This district's proportion of the enumerated population was a mere one percent.

Overall the district of Castries accounted for 40 percent of the enumerated population in Saint Lucia's 2001 Population and Housing Census. This percentage is slightly higher than the corresponding percentage of 39 percent recorded in 1991. However, in reference to persons who were actually counted, in 2001 there were 8,396 more persons living in the Castries District than in 1991. This represents the largest increase in population magnitudes among the ten districts.

The district of Gros Islet experienced the greatest percentage increase in population. In 2001, Gros Islet's population was 54.6 percent more than it was in 1991. This means that, since 1991, Gros Islet's population has increased by an average of over 5 percent a year.

Among Saint Lucia's ten districts, six districts encountered household population percentage expansions. Micoud's household population grew by 6.3 percent. This was the smallest percentage growth among the six districts that expanded.

Household population percentage contractions ranged from 0.3 percent to 4.3 percent. The district of Choiseul had the largest household population percentage decrease.

The island-nation of Saint Lucia recorded an overall household population increase of 18.1 percent.

HOUSEHOLDS:

For Saint Lucia's 2001 Population and Housing Census 47,124 private households were enumerated. There were 14,045 more households enumerated in 2001 than in 1991 when 33,079 private households were counted.

The average household size for Saint Lucia decreased from 4.0 persons per household in 1991 to 3.2 persons per household in 2001. On the district level, the average household sizes ranged from 3.6 persons, recorded in the district of Soufriere, to 3.0 persons reported in the district of Gros Islet. In contrasting the censuses of 1991 and 2001, all the districts in Saint Lucia experienced a decline in their average household size. The district of Laborie recorded the sharpest decline, where the average household size fell from 4.5 persons in 1991 to 3.4 persons in 2001.

The standard of living within Saint Lucian households improved steadily over the ten years since 1991. Many more households, across the island, attained access to the basic amenities required to alleviate situations of poverty. However, the individuals who comprise these households may not have fared as well. Census figures provide no indication that the present academic and technical skills of Saint Lucia's population are enough to offer a solution to the high rates of unemployment reported in every district throughout the island.
