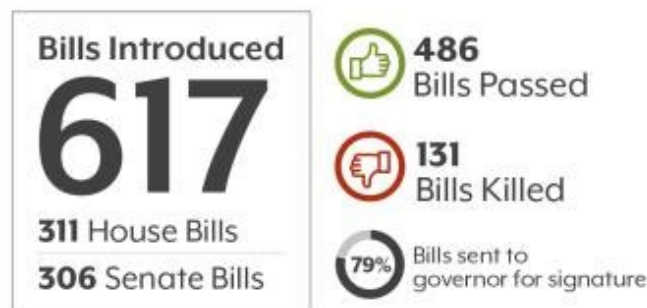

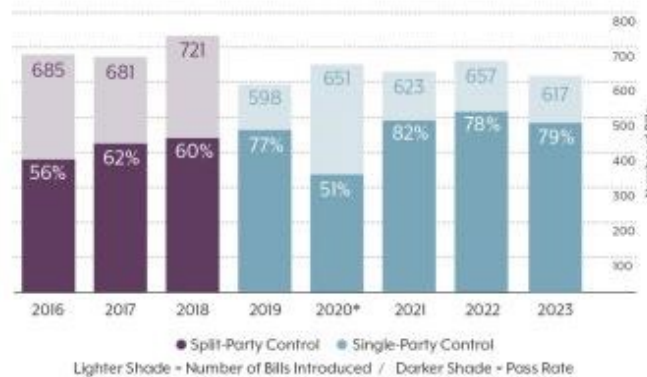
## Legislative Session Colorado's 74<sup>th</sup> General Assembly

The first regular session of Colorado's 74th General Assembly convened on January 9, 2023, and adjourned on May 8, 2023.  
617 bills were introduced this session.

When the Seventy-fourth General Assembly convened on January 9, 2023, there were at least 21 new representatives and 10 new senators. At least two of the persons elected to leadership positions in the House: Speaker of the House and Majority Leader, and at least one of the persons elected to a leadership position in the Senate, the Minority Leader, were new to their positions.

Behavioral health continued to be a focus of the General Assembly in 2023. Several bills addressing behavioral health services, mental health providers, step therapy requirements for mental health drugs, substance use, and disordered eating were considered during the legislative session.

The General Assembly also addressed many bills related to human services especially improving services offered to children and youth, considering several measures related to kindergarten through twelfth grade (K-12) education in Colorado. Specifically, the legislature adopted bills related to preschool, special education and students with disabilities.

The General Assembly passed an array of measures concerning the criminal and juvenile justice system. Lawmakers specifically debated policies about courts, crime, incarceration, sentencing, behavioral health, and law enforcement.

The General Assembly examined a number of measures related to civil law including reproductive and civil rights., notably, the Disability task force was formed. House Bill 23-1296 creates the Rights of Coloradans with Disabilities Task Force. The task force includes four subcommittees to identify any barriers, gaps, or deficiencies in existing laws, regulations, policies, and practices that affect the rights and inclusion of individuals with disabilities.

### Top 6 Priority Bills

#### HB 23-1168 Legal Representation of Students with Disabilities

Representatives Sharbini and Joseph  
Senator Winter

- Creates a pool of pro bono attorneys
- The attorneys will represent parents who are being sued by a school district in a due process hearing
- The complaint that is filed by the school district must be limited to the following situation:
  - ✓ An issue was raised by the parent in the Colorado Department of Education's state complaint process
  - ✓ The parent received a favorable decision from the state complaint officer
  - ✓ The school district is challenging that decision by filing a due process complain in the Office of Administrative Courts

SUPPORT – After actively engaging with Disability Law Colorado, The Consortium of Special Education Directors, The Colorado Rural Schools Alliance, The Colorado Association of School Boards, school district attorneys from across the state, and private special education law attorneys for parents, the group drafted this bill that will provide a much needed resource for parents that will effectively level the playing field for parents that engage in filing a state complaint using Colorado Department of Education's state complaint process. The Arc of Colorado provided in-person testimony before the House and Senate Education Committees. The bill passed unanimously out of both committees.

STATUS – Bill signed by the Governor.

#### SB 23-064 Office of Public Guardianship

Representative Snyder  
Senators Gardner and Ginal

- Extends the continuation of the Office of Public Guardianship (OPG) indefinitely
- Expands the Office of Public Guardianship throughout the state of Colorado by December 31, 2027
- Board membership must include a person with lived experience

- The training program that is provided by OPG to the guardians must include information about less restrictive alternatives to guardianship, including supported decision making and limited guardianship  
SUPPORT – The Arc of Colorado testified in-person before the Senate Judiciary Committee where the bill passed unanimously. A signature of support by The Arc of Colorado was offered before the House Judiciary Committee where it passed 12 to 1. All amendments that The Arc of Colorado offered were adopted into the bill and are expected to be signed into law. These amendments included the less restrictive alternative language and the addition of a board member to the Office of Public Guardianship who is a person with lived-experience.

Bill signed by the Governor.

### **HB 23-1197 Stakeholder Process for Oversight of Host Home Providers** **Representative Young**

- Health Care Policy and Finance (HCPF) must engage in a stakeholder process by September 1, 2023
- The goal of the stakeholder process is to strengthen oversight of host homes
- Members of the group will include, but is not limited to, Program Approved Service Agencies (PASA's), Case Management Agencies, Host Home Providers, Individuals with Lived Experience, Advocacy Groups Representing the Disability

SUPPORT – As a result of a report that issued by the Department of Regulatory Agencies in the fall of 2022, The Arc of Colorado, Colorado Cross Disability Coalition, The Arc of Aurora, The Arc of Weld County, and Representative Mary Young joined forces with Health Care Policy and Finance to construct a bill that would address the issues of abuse and neglect towards people with disabilities in host homes. The bill creates a task force that will work towards clarifying and strengthening the regulations around the oversight of host home providers. The Arc of Aurora and The Arc of Aurora provided in-person before the House Committee on Health and Insurance and written testimony to the Senate Committee on Health and Human Services.

Bill signed into law by the Governor.

### **HB 23-1291 Procedures for Expulsion Hearing Officers** **Representatives Gonzales-Gutierrez and Joseph** **Senator Winter**

- Clarifies requirements for expulsion hearings and their officers to promote fairness and prevent conflicts of interest
- Increases the training for expulsion hearing officers, including training around disabilities and trauma-informed care and interventions
- Expands data reporting around expulsion hearing results and how expulsion hearing officer recommendations are regarded by Superintendents and/or Boards of Education

SUPPORT – The Arc of Colorado provided technical assistance in support of this bill. The bill will impact students with disabilities in that it will ensure that hearing officers are trained on the rights and protections that students have when it comes to suspension and expulsions. The Arc of Colorado provided written testimony before the House Education Committee and the Senate Committee on State, Veterans, and Military Affairs.

Bill signed by the Governor.

**HB 23 1042- Admissibility Standards for Juvenile Statements**

**Representatives Bacon and Sharbini**  
**Senator Gonzales**

- Any statement or admission obtained during a juvenile custodial interrogation in which a law enforcement official knowingly uses deception prior to or during the custodial interrogation is presumptively inadmissible against the juvenile in an evidentiary hearing
  - ✓ unless the prosecution proves by a preponderance of the evidence based on the totality of the circumstances that the statement or admission was made voluntarily
- The court shall consider for totality of circumstances all evidence presented concerning the juvenile's vulnerability to any deception used during the custodial interrogation
- The bill directs the Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) board to develop a live, virtual, interactive training program for peace officers on the enforcement of laws related to custodial interrogation of juveniles to ensure uniform interpretation of the law
- The P.O.S.T. training will include awareness of effective communication accommodations that are required pursuant to Title II of The Americans with Disabilities Act

Bill signed by the Governor.

**HB 23-1249 End Childhood Prosecution Bill**

**Representatives Armagost and Gonzales-Gutierrez**

- Ends the prosecution and detention of kids ages 10 to 12 by July 2024
- Expands the list of referring entities that can refer a child, family, and victim to the Collaborative Management Programs (CMP) for services
- Utilizes CMP's to coordinate local services for kids who need them
- Improves coordination for victims by allowing the CMP to refer victims directly to services and resources
- Creates a referral process for kids to be referred to the CMP
- Allows law enforcement to take control of situations to maintain the safety of a child and others

Bill signed by the Governor.
