8 TROJANS BREAK RELAY RECORD

Four Southern California relay runners finished 2nd to four ex-Southern California sprinters, but still got a world record at the Sun Devil Classic.

In the most incredible 2-lap relay ever run the Tobias Striders lowered the world 4 x 200 record to 1:20.2 (1:20.23), but won't achieve official world record status because all the runners were not from the same country. (Indeed, they represented 4 countries!)

But the current Trojan crop was all American and will get credit for a record at 1:20.3 (1:20.26).

That was just part of an amazing little relay carnival which also saw Tobias run 38.55, Southern Cal 3:03.3y and Villanova 3:16.5.

Elsewhere, the women's collegiate season climaxed in superb fashion at the AIAW, with three world records, an AR and three CRs.
